LAVC’s Information Technology Department has been **named as one of five finalists in the “Servers and Virtualization” category for Computerworld’s 2008 “Best Practices in Infrastructure Management” Awards Program**. LAVC has made significant improvements to the efficiency of its infrastructure through virtualization and server consolidation, established best practices to ensure that all rollouts are flexible and cost-effective, and developed a strategic approach to technology that can be emulated by others. In the “server and virtualization” category, LAVC is competing against several private corporations including Fannie Mae and Nationwide Insurance, and educational institutions such as Franklin & Marshall College and the University of Alabama-Birmingham School of Medicine and Family Practice Residency Program’s Huntsville Hospital.
