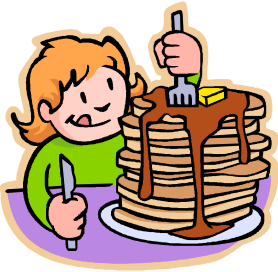

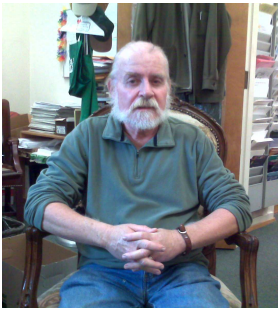
#### Greater Valley Glen Council's Pancake Breakfast and Community Safety Fair

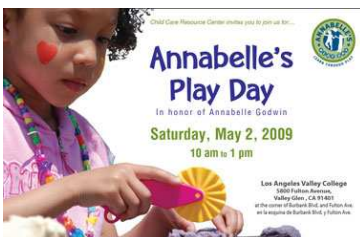
### LAVC Theater Arts Presents *Alice*<sup>n</sup>
