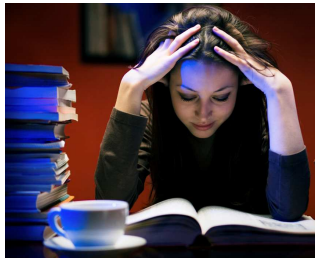

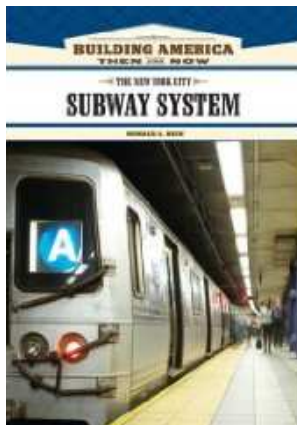
LAVC Speech Team honored by Economic Alliance
