



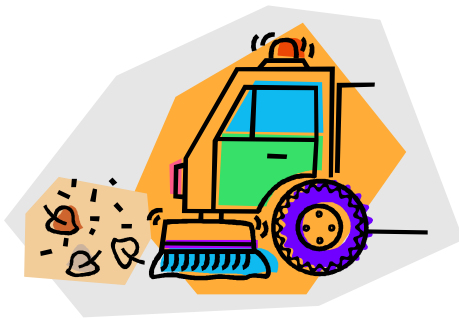

Construction Notification – Campus Wide Street Sweeping

on June 26-27

There will be a campus-wide street sweeping on the weekend of June 26-27.
