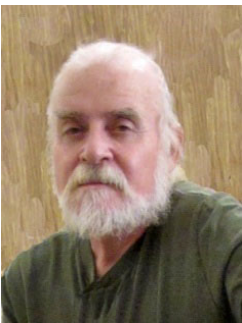
**Attention LAVC Faculty and Staff! Don't Miss the Annual Spring Service Awards and Recognition Ice Cream Social on May 19!**
