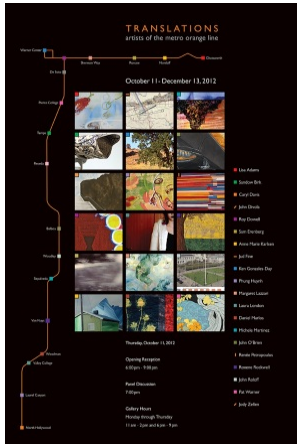

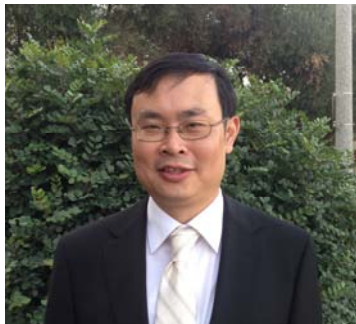
KVCM's 3rd Annual Holiday Music Marathon Beginning on December 10
