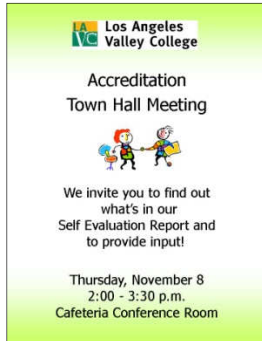

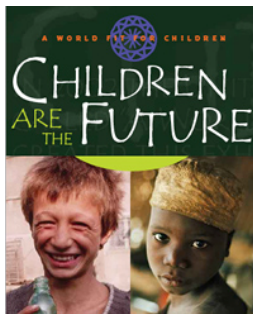
LAVC Family Resource Center to Offer a Special Community Workshop on “Touchpoints: Stresses & Supports for Families”
