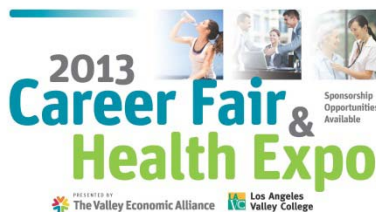

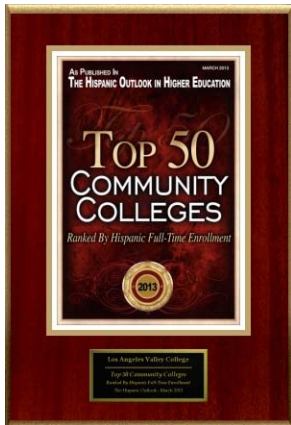
LAVC to Hold a Career Fair & Health Expo on April 17
