LAVC Announces Its New Mission Statement, Vision Statement and Core Values

The Los Angeles Community College District's Board of Trustees has formally approved LAVC's new Mission Statement, Vision Statement and Core Values. The revisions to the mission and vision statements and core values began a year-and-a-half ago. Following the college procedure to regularly review its mission and vision statements and core values, the Educational Planning Committee (EPC) created a workgroup begin the process in Spring 2011. After crafting revised statements, the workgroup sought feedback from a broad base of constituents (including students, student government leaders, club members, faculty, staff, administrators, alumni, LAVC Foundation members, advisory committees, and the community) via an online survey, and the college held a President's Sidewalk Chat. Using that feedback, the workgroup further revised the statements and engaged in dialogue with the Academic Senate. The Institutional Effectiveness Council (IEC) approved on December 4, and it was formally approved by the Board on February 6. 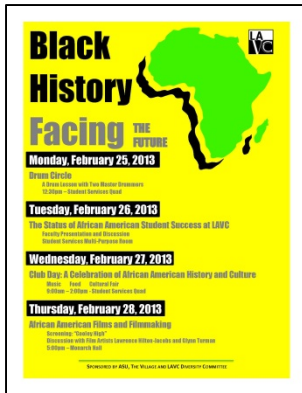

Exhibition; Exhibit Ends April 11

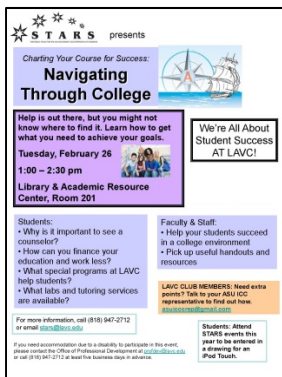
The LAVC Art Gallery will present a new exhibition entitled "Gegam Kacherian: Thirty-Six Year Survey"

The state committee selected Avanesian for leading the Monarchs to a 6-1 record in the month with wins over two ranked teams. She is also the leading the Western State Conference South Division with 19.0 ppg; she has averaged 17.9 ppg, 9 rpg, 2.1 apg, and 2.2 spg.
