LAVC to Celebrate Student Achievement at the Spring 2013 Dean's Reception

LAVC Student Activities, Associated Student Union, and Tau Alpha Epsilon will honor outstanding students at the Spring 2013 Dean's Reception on Thursday, March 21 at 1 p.m. in Monarch Hall. This semi-annual event recognizes students who have made the Dean's List and President's Honor's List. The featured speaker at the event will be Lloyd S. Jones, the LAVC's first student and a member of the college's Pioneer Class (1949). Students selected to the Dean's List are full-time students with at least a 3.5 GPA in 12 or more units at LAVC, or part-time students with at least a 3.5 GPA in 6-11 units who have completed more than 12 cumulative units at LAVC. Students who have been on the Dean's List for three consecutive semesters are selected to be on the President's Honor's List. In addition, all students with a 3.5 GPA or higher are eligible to be a member of the Phi Theta Kappa, a national honor society for 2-year colleges, and Tau Alpha Epsilon, LAVC's honor society.
