#### LAVC Astronomy Group to Present a "Our Nearest Star: Space Weather and You" Astronomy Lecture on May 5

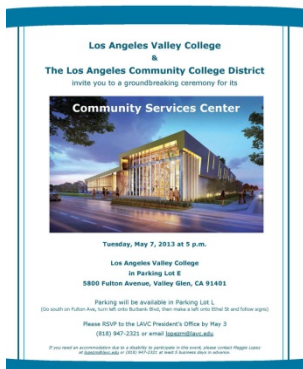
*The LAVC Astronomy Group will present a free astronomy lecture entitled "Our Nearest Star: Space Weather and You" lecture by Dr. Tamitha Mulligan Skov of The Aerospace Corporation on Sunday, May 5 at 7:45 p.m. in the LAVC Planetarium.* This one-hour talk will give an overview of the solar phenomena that cause Space Weather, how it affects the Earth system, and what impacts it has on life and society. Dr. Mulligan will explain how all life on Earth depends on our nearest star—the Sun—and how "space weather" causes a wide variety of issues that affect our daily lives such as disruption of satellite GPS signals to the beautiful light displays of the aurora. Dr. Mulligan Skov is a research scientist at The Aerospace Corporation in Los Angeles. She

### Three LAVC Students Receive the 2013 Jack Kent Cooke Undergraduate Transfer Scholarships

**Valley College Students Mandolyn Ludlum, Freddy Rosas, and Melissa Gordon have been selected to receive a 2013 Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship by the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation. Valley College was eligible to nominate up to three candidates, and all three of its candidates were selected to receive the scholarship.** The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation Undergraduate Transfer Scholarship Program, the largest private scholarship for community college transfer students in the country, provides up to \$30,000 per year for up to three years to community college students who are nominated by their schools based on a number of factors including academic excellence and financial need. A total of 73 scholarships were awarded by the Jack Kent Cooke Foundation based on the 769 nominations from 377 community colleges in the United States it received. The chosen scholars stood out for their exceptional academic ability and achievements, financial need, persistence, leadership, and desire to help others. They were selected by a prestigious committee made up of 37 admissions professionals and professors, mostly from selective four-year institutions, as well as from community colleges.
