LA County Sheriff's Department to Film an Active Shooter Response Training Video at Valley College on April 8-10

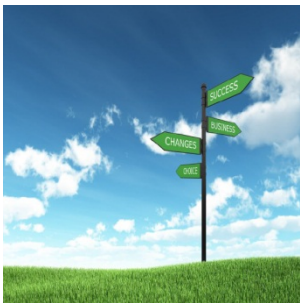
LAVC has been selected by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department to be the filming location for its new "Run, Hide, Fight" Active Shooter Response Training video. Filming will take place on campus on April 8-10, which is during the college's Spring Break, in the following areas on campus: the LAVC Fulton Avenue Main Entrance, Arcade, Monarch Square, Library and Academic Resource Center, Campus Drive, and the areas between the Library and the Foreign Language Building. During those dates, the campus community may see an increased presence of law enforcement personnel and equipment related to the filming around the campus. The Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department is creating this video as part of its Active

Shooter Response Trainings it is holding for the Los Angeles Community College District. In addition, it will use the video in its Active Shooter Response Trainings that will be conducted nationally and internationally. The LAVC Counseling Department and the LAVC Career/Transfer Center, in collaboration with Cooperative Education and Career Technical Education, is presenting a series of workshops from April 14- 16 to help students navigate through the career development process.
