Need Tutoring? LAVC Tutoring Services will be Open during Summer Session 2014

The LAVC Writing Center, General Tutoring Center, and Math Lab are open to provide tutoring support to assist students during Summer Session 2014. In addition, the Computer Commons and Library will be open. Tutoring services will be available in the following areas: assistance with writing assignments, general tutoring in subjects (such as statistics, chemistry, economics, etc.), and math tutoring.

- For assistance with writing assignments or general tutoring on subjects (e.g. statistics, chemistry, economics, etc.), students should visit the Writing Center / General Tutoring in LARC 229. Its hours of operation are Monday and Wednesday from 1:00-6:30 p.m., Tuesday and Thursday from 10:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. Tutoring sessions are scheduled by appointment only; please call (818) 947-2810 or stop by during its open hours to schedule an appointment.
- For assistance with math courses, students should go to the Math Lab in LARC 225. The Math Lab's hours of operation are Monday-Thursday from 11:15 a.m.-6:15 p.m., and Friday from 11:15 a.m.-2 p.m.; tutoring is offered on a walk-in basis.

Please note: Students who wish to use the Tutoring Lab and Computer Commons must show their student ID (Monarch Card). In addition, Tutoring Labs (except Transfer Math Lab & Computer Commons) will require enrollment in a section of "Supervised Learning".
