LAVC to Celebrate Student Achievement at its Spring 2014 Dean's Reception

LAVC Associated Student Union and Tau Alpha Epsilon will honor outstanding students at the Spring 2014 Dean's Reception on Monday, March 17 at 12:30 p.m. in Monarch Hall. This semi-annual event recognizes students who have made the Dean's List and President's Honor's List. Students selected to the Dean's List are full-time students with at least a 3.5 GPA in 12 or more units at LAVC, or part-time students with at least a 3.5 GPA in 6-11 units who have completed more than 12 cumulative units at LAVC. Students who have been on the Dean's List for three consecutive semesters are selected to be on the President's Honor's List. In addition, all students with a 3.5 GPA or higher are eligible to be a member of the Phi Theta Kappa, a national honor society for 2-year colleges, and Tau Alpha Epsilon, LAVC's honor society. LAVC Art Gallery Celebrates its 50th Anniversary with a "Passing Time: 50 Years of Exhibitions" Exhibit Until April 24

The LAVC Art Gallery is celebrating its 50th anniversary with an exhibition highlighting past shows titled "Passing Time: 50 Years of Exhibitions" from March 13-April 24, 2014. This exhibition presents highlights from 23 exhibitions held in the gallery during its first half-century (1964-2014). Highlights include "Japanese American Photography in Los Angeles, 1920-1945" (shown in 1982), a presentation of recovered photographs once exhibited world-wide but believed lost during the Japanese American relocation of WWII; "The Furniture of Gustav Stickley" (shown in 1983), a survey of the American Arts & Crafts master; Creativity in the Shadow of

Political Oppression: "Recent Czechoslovakian Graphic Art from the Werksman Collection" (shown in 1991), an exhibit of prints by artists who produced work about, and in spite of, the political tyranny of the Communist era in Czechoslovakia; "Sitting Pretty: Chairs of the Twentieth Century" (shown in 2007), celebrated the beauty of these functional necessities; "Cultural Windows: the Art of Ruth Asawa, Ynez Johnston, Betye Saar" (shown in 2010) explored the effects of various cultures and subcultures upon the work of these three veteran woman artists. 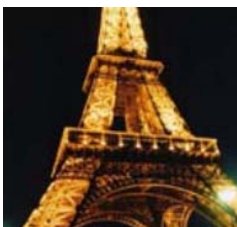
Free CPR Training and Certification for LAVC Faculty, Staff and Students

LA Valley College Honored with the 2013 American Red Cross Platinum Award

The American Red Cross awarded Los Angeles Valley College with its 2013 Red Cross Platinum Award on March 7. Sonia Nodal of the LAVC Student Health Center accepted the award on behalf of the college. The American Red Cross gave the Platinum award to LAVC because its successful efforts to increase the total units of blood the campus community donated by 43% in 2013. In 2013, the American Red Cross generously received over 300 units of blood, which can save over 900 lives, through the LAVC Blood Drives! The LAVC Student Health Center works closely with the American Red Cross to set up campus blood drives every month during each semester. It also created a Super Star Donor program to honor those individuals who donate three whole blood donations or 2 ALYX donations during the school year; the Super Star Donors are recognized in May with a certificate and prizes. The LAVC Student Health Center would like to thank all the faculty, staff, and students for their diligent efforts to either promote the blood drives or be generous donors in helping LAVC receive the 2013 Platinum Award.
