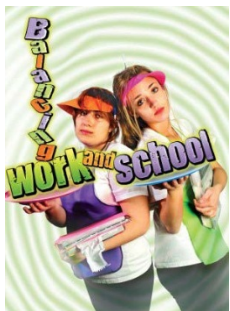

Dr. Fernando Rodriguez Named as the New Chancellor of the LA Community College District by the LACCD Board of Trustees

The Board of Trustees of the Los Angeles Community College District has announced that it has selected Dr. Francisco Rodriguez, superintendent/president of the Mira Costa Community College District, to be LACCD's next chancellor. The selection of the new chancellor took place following a 10-month recruitment and selection process conducted by the Association for Community College Trustees. Dr. Rodriguez has been at his current position at Mira Costa Community College District for the last five years and overall in higher education for nearly 30 years. He has both a bachelor's and master's degree from UC Davis and a Ph.D. in education from Oregon State University. Dr. Rodriguez will assume his new position at LACCD on June 1.



LAVC Student Selected to Visit NASA as part of the National Community College Aerospace Scholars Project

Lewis Marquez, a LAVC student, has been selected to travel to NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center this spring to participate in the National Community College Aerospace Scholars project (NCAS). Marquez is one of 40 community and junior college students from across the nation selected to participate. NCAS is a semester-long scholars program, culminating a three-day on-site event at Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, California and offers students from across the nation the opportunity to interact NASA engineers and other participants as they learn more about careers in science and engineering. While at NASA, students will form teams and establish fictional companies interested in Mars exploration. Each team will be responsible for developing a prototype rover, designing a 3d model of their rover and forming a company infrastructure, including budget, communications and presentations. The on-site experience at NASA includes a tour of facilities and briefings by NASA subject matter experts.



Elmida Baghdaserians, Child Development Department Chair, will Present at the CAEYC Conference

Elmida Baghdaserians, chair of the Child Development Department, will present at the 2014 California Association for the Education of Young Children (CAEYC) Conference on April 5 in Pasadena. Her presentation geared towards college faculty, titled "Adult Learning Theory and the ECE field", will share how in the early 1970s Malcolm Knowles introduced the term "andragogy" describing differences between children and adult learners. Andragogy focuses on special needs of adult learners. Knowles identified six assumptions about adult learning: (1) need to know, (2) self-concept, (3) prior experience, (4) readiness to learn, (5) learning orientation, and (6) motivation to learn. In this presentation faculty will also focus on the following items: pedagogy and andragogy the connection of these theories and how it applies in the field of ECE. Congratulations Elmida!



Marni Roosevelt, FRC Director, Receives a Fellowship!

Marni Roosevelt, Director of the Family Resource Center (FRC), has been awarded a prestigious fellowship with the Simms/Mann Institute. She is one of 6 fellows selected from throughout the entire state of California. Through the upcoming year she will work on a research project that was inspired by this year's Think Tank that featured Dr. Ruth Feldman and Dr. Kyle Pruett from Yale University Child Study Center. Their area of expertise is on the neurobiological aspects of fatherhood. The Simms/Mann Institute Think Tank and Fellowship is a unique public/private partnership that is creating a cross-sector network of leaders to address the current and future needs of the early care workforce. This is the first program of its kind to be implemented at the community college level. Marni is the only person from the LACCD who has been awarded this honor. Congratulations Marni!
