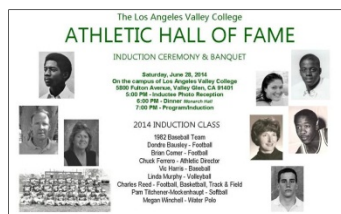
**You're Invited to an Opening Reception on May 22 for the LAVC Art Gallery's "Student Art Show 2014" Exhibition**

**Introducing Deanna Heikkinen, LAVC's Distance Education Coordinator**

**Deanna Heikkinen was hired as the college's Distance Education Coordinator in February. In her new role, she is responsible for coordinating the distance education offerings at Valley College, and works with the online technical support assistant to ensure that online classes are set up correctly and assists faculty with using the distance education system.** Deanna also works with faculty and department chairs to share best practices in distance education, and handles distance education issues for accreditation. She is excited to be in this position and to be able to work with faculty to integrate technology in online, web enhanced, and regular face-to-face classes and make classroom time more interesting for students. LAVC's distance education classes are doing better than the national average compared to face-to-face instruction. As chair of the Campus Distance Education Committee (CDEC), she would like to let the campus know that CDEC has spent the last year developing a distance education plan, which will be vetted by the campus. During the recent accreditation visit, the team was impressed by our distance education strategic plan and what the college has done to improve distance education since last year. Deanna has been teaching online for over 7 years at community colleges from San Diego to Lake Tahoe. She has her master's degrees in History and Anthropology in Archeology from Cal State Bakersfield, and is getting her doctorate in higher education at Cal Lutheran University.
