LAVC Foundation Scholarship Applications Now Available to LAVC Students

The Los Angeles Valley College Foundation is accepting scholarship applications from LAVC students between January 9-March 13. The deadline to submit an application for most scholarships is Friday, March 13 at 4 p.m. To be eligible for a scholarship, the individual must be registered and enrolled for the Spring 2015 semester at LA Valley College. The student must be prepared to answer questions (such as the Grade Point Average, the number of units that he/she has completed, and the area of study) so that Foundation staff can assist in providing the scholarship applications that the student may qualify for. International students may also apply. 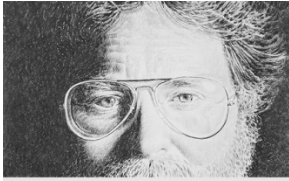

Get Paid to Learn! LAVC Students and Faculty Invited to the CSUN BUILD PODER Program Information Session on February 23

The California State Northridge (CSUN) Program and LAVC will hold an information session for students and faculty on CSUN's Building Infrastructure Leading to Diversity (BUILD) Promoting Opportunities for Diversity in Education and Research (PODER) Program on Monday, February 23 from 2-3 p.m. The student information session will be held in the Fireside Room in Campus Center; the LAVC faculty information session will be held in Campus Center 104. BUILD PODER is a paid student research training and faculty enrichment program designed to strengthen research training and mentoring in behavioral, biomedical, and health sciences. Students at CSUN and LAVC will collaborate on biomedical research with faculty mentors. Students who are BUILD PODER trainees (sophomores) and scholars (junior and seniors) receive a stipend, tuition, funding for some books, funding to travel to a conference, and a small research supply stipend. BUILD PODER faculty mentors receive training in culturally competent mentoring and may be chosen by a student to work on the faculty member's research. In addition, BUILD PODER Mentors can apply for Pilot

Project grants for \$50,000, reassigned time to rewrite courses to be in line with BUILD PODER's goals, or they can join an NIH Faculty Scholar Academy to learn how to and/or receive reassigned time to write an NIH grant proposal. For more information, visit the [CSUN BUILD PODER Web page](#).

Final Week of the Special Exhibition by LA Muralist Kent Twitchell in the LAVC Art Gallery; Exhibit Closes on February 26

The LAVC Art Gallery will reopen its "Life Line: Drawings by Kent Twitchell" exhibition from February 9-26 in the LAVC Art Gallery in the Art Building. This exhibition by Los Angeles-based muralist Kent Twitchell focuses on his life-long devotion to drawing as his primary medium, and also his connections to his subjects. It highlights the artist's small graphite on paper renderings that are both intimate and engaging in scale. Culled from the artist's oeuvre, some of the drawings in this exhibition are being displayed for the first time. Twitchell is renowned for his larger-than-life, realistic portrayals of celebrities and creative luminaries in murals sprawling Los Angeles's buildings and freeways. As the exhibition title suggests, "Life Line" conjures up multiple associations. "Life Line" also serves as a stimulating pairing to the monumental and iconic mural of "The Old Woman of the Freeway" (or "Freeway Lady") that will be installed on the side of this campus's Student Services Center this year. Need to Take the HiSET® (High School Equivalency Test)? LAVC to Offer the Computer-Based and the Paper-Based Test; Practice Test Also Offered

The LAVC CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Program is now accepting registrations for the HiSET® (High School Equivalency Test). LAVC is an official HiSET testing site; the computer-based tests will be offered on Tuesday-Wednesday, February 24-25 and Saturday, February 28, and the paper-based test on Friday-Saturday, February 27-28. It will also offer the practice test on Friday, February 27; practice tests are also available by appointment. HiSET® is the new alternative to the GED. The CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET® for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. It is offered as a paper-based or computer-based test, and covers the following subject areas: Language Arts- Reading & Writing, Science, Social Studies and Mathematics. Both types of tests are offered on a regular basis. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 (non-refundable). The fee for the practice test is \$10. 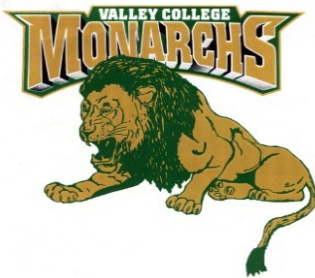

- **Attention Students—Sign Up Now to Receive Emergency Alerts on your Cell Phone and Private Email Address!** LAVC has launched a new emergency notification system. You're being urged to provide your cell phone number and an alternate email address to receive emergency alerts. In the event of an emergency, you will automatically receive an email to your LACCD email address as well as your home phone. If you would like to be contacted by text message or at another email address, you will need to provide that information on the new [LAVC Connect Portal](#).
- **Don't Forget! February 22 is the Last Day Drop a Class without incurring fees, with refund of enrollment fees, and without receiving a "W".** The LAVC Admissions & Records Office reminds all students that the last day to drop classes (by internet only) without incurring fees, with refund of enrollment fees, and without receiving a "W" for Spring 2015 is Sunday, February 22. If you stop attending (or wish to drop a class), you must drop the class yourself—officially—over the internet on or before May 10, 2015; failure to do so by the posted deadline may result in a grade of "F" in that class. LAVC is urging all LAVC faculty and staff to provide emergency contact information to Valley College through the new [LAVC Connect portal](#). During a campus emergency, LAVC will be notifying all students, faculty and staff using a new emergency alert system called Blackboard Connect. This new system has the ability to let LAVC send emergency alert notifications simultaneously to students, staff and faculty by email, voice, and text message.
