H. Dennis and Anne Beaver Foundation Selects an LAVC Student to Receive an All-Expenses-Paid Summer Study Abroad Trip to Paris, France

The H. Dennis and Anne Beaver Foundation announced that it has selected Jessica Zaldana, an LAVC student in French 5, to receive an all-expenses paid trip to participate in a study abroad program in Paris,

France this summer. Jessica, who is also a student in the TRiO program, will study for a month this summer at the Institut Catholique in Paris with the European Studies Association (ESA). To maximize her exposure to the language, she will be staying with a host family. Jessica plans to apply for transfer this fall as a double major in French and Spanish, and use her language skills for work internationally. For many years, LAVC Alumnus Dennis Beaver and his foundation have encouraged foreign language study at the high school- and university-level by sending gifted, financially deserving, and highly motivated students to study in France. Every year, the H. Dennis and Anne Beaver Foundation has awarded a scholarship to study in France to one or two LAVC and/or CSUN students. The scholarship covers all trip expenses, including travel, room and board, tuition and a modest weekly allowance to cover some meals and incidentals. Two LAVC Students Accepted into Space-Related Summer Internship Programs

LAVC Student Natalie Barseghian has been accepted into the Consortium for Undergraduate Research and Education in Astronomy (CURREA)'s 2015 Summer program at Mt. Wilson Observatory, and LAVC Student Luis Diaz has been accepted into the Consortium for Undergraduate Research Experience (CURE) program for the Summer of 2015. The CURREA program is an intensive two-week course in observational astronomy, designed to introduce undergraduate students of physics and astronomy to elements of observational solar and stellar astrophysics; Natalie is an Astrophysics major. The CURE program offers a paid internship at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, CA, in the areas of astronomy, astrophysics, planetary science, and space explorations; Luis, who is a Mechanical Engineering major, will be working on instrumentation development. Both students, who are enrolled in Astronomy classes taught by David Falk, competed with students from other community colleges to be accepted into these highly selective programs. Natalie is enrolled in the Astronomy 5 observational laboratory class, and Luis is enrolled in the Astronomy 1 lecture and the Astronomy 5 observational laboratory classes. Congratulations!
