Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) is offering 54 short-term, late-start class sections in the Fall 2015 Semester. These classes, which scheduled to start the week of October 19, include a wide selection of UC/CSU-transferable including online or hybrid courses. Late-start courses will be available in the high-demand subjects of English, Math, Communication Studies, Anthropology, Political Science, Art, and more. [LAVC RECEIVES A \\$360,000 GRANT TO HELP IMPROVE STUDENT SUCCESS](#)



The U.S. Department of Education Office of Postsecondary Education H.S.I. Title V Cooperative has awarded a \$650,000 grant to Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) to develop and implement strategies to help improve student success at all three institutions. "Engaging for Student Success" is a cooperative project with East Los Angeles College (ELAC) and Los Angeles Trade-Tech College (LATTTC). All three institutions will work together to develop activities that address low progress rates, low persistence and low completion rates of students. The grant focuses on the following three areas: faculty development, adaptive course learning and a one stop student support. Valley College is taking the lead on the area of faculty development by establishing a teaching innovation academy for instructors who teach students who are at-risk of failing or repeating "gateway" course. It will also work with ELAC and LATTTC on exploring technology-blended learning environments for students, and will observe ELAC's one stop student support component. In addition, as part of this grant, there is an Endowment Match component to allow for continued professional development after the grant ends. FREE EXERCISE CLASS ON CAMPUS! COME TO DANCE AND STRETCH CONDITIONING CLASS ON OCTOBER 7

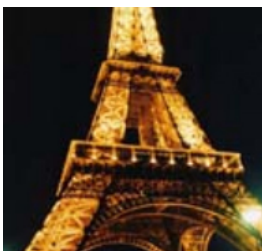

[WANT TO TAKE THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST? LAST CHANCE TO REGISTER FOR THE OCTOBER PAPER-BASED HISET; PRACTICE TESTS ALSO AVAILABLE](#)

The LAVC CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Office will offer the paper-based High School Equivalency Test (or HiSET®) on Friday-Saturday, October 16 and 17; the last day to register is October 7 in Bungalow 14. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. In

addition, the HiSET practice test will be offered at 9 a.m. on Friday, October 9 in Bungalow 14; check-in at 8:45 a.m. The HiSET is the new alternative to the GED; the CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. To be eligible to take the HiSET, you must be a California resident, be 18 years or older, have a valid government issued identification, and not be currently enrolled in high school. The HiSET paper-based test is held monthly on a Friday and Saturday (participants must attend both days for each session); the registration deadline is 7 business days before the test date.

The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 and additional fees may apply (non-refundable). Space is limited and pre-registration is required. The HiSET practice test will give you an idea of how well you may score on the official HiSET test. They are offered at 9 a.m. on designated Fridays (October 9, 16, 23, and 30) in Bungalow 14; participants must check-in by 8:45 a.m. The practice test is also available by appointment. Dates are subject to change without notice. The fee for the test is \$10.00 (non-refundable).
