[NEW EXTENDED HOURS OF OPERATION FOR THE LAVC LIBRARY; NOW OPEN ON THE EVENINGS AND ON SATURDAYS](#)

The LAVC Library has recently extended hours of operation in the evenings and weekends. As of September 28, the LAVC Library is open Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-8:45 p.m., Friday from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. These changes were made to provide students more opportunities to use its facilities and its information resources. The LAVC Library, which is located on the first floor of the Library and Academic Resource Center (LARC), is available to assist students with locating resources for their research projects, and for their personal interest. It has more than 130,000 printed books, including textbooks on reserve, and provides access to nearly 170,000 eBooks. In addition, the Library has more than 60 public computers with Internet access and Microsoft Office for currently enrolled students and faculty. There are also group study rooms, as well as individual study areas, plus spaces for listening to and watching audiovisual materials. Photocopying and computer printing is also available in the Library. The Library is open during the academic school year, but is closed Sundays and school holidays. 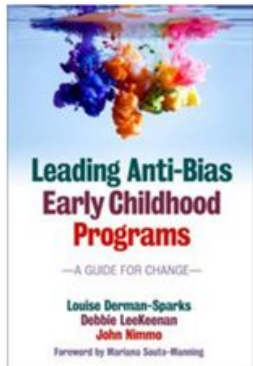

The LAVC Art Gallery is proud to present "Newsworthy (Photographs Making History)", which is a group exhibition that explores the power of the photographic image through the genre of photojournalism, from October 15-December 17. An opening reception for the exhibition will be held on Thursday, October 15, from 6-9 p.m. in the LAVC Art Gallery. In addition, there will be a panel discussion on "Photojournalism and the World" will be held from 7-8 p.m. in the Art Lecture Hall (Art 103), which is located down the hall from the Art Gallery. The panel discussion will be moderated by Sam Lee, adjunct professor art and LAVC art gallery director, and will feature panelist: Roderick Lyons, photographer; associate professor of photography, LAVC; Dennis Reed, collector, and former dean of arts and emeritus professor of art, LAVC; Stephen White, collector, gallerist, and independent curator of photography. "Newsworthy (Photographs Making History)" brings together a selection of approximately 40 photographs that depict significant events in our world history from the 1920s to 1990s, ranging from public assassinations and executions to war and genocide. This exhibition focuses on images that were taken before the digital era, using the analog, film process, and on the prints that were produced by hand in the darkroom. Both are considered archaic to today's practices of disseminate news-breaking stories. The LAVC Art Gallery is located in the Art Building.
