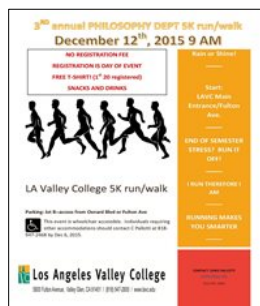
[LAVC TO HOLD ITS ANNUAL HOLIDAY PARTY FOR EMPLOYEES ON DECEMBER 10](#)

ATHLETICS UPDATE—WOMEN'S SOCCER COACH NAMED WSC COACH OF THE YEAR AND MEN'S FOOTBALL ARE THE GOLDEN STATE BOWL CHAMPS!

The LAVC Athletics Department congratulates Women's Soccer Coach Greg Venger for his unanimous selection as the 2015 Western State Conference (WSC)

Coach of the Year! Greg led the Lady Monarchs to their first playoff appearance in the history of the sport at Valley College. It also congratulates Men's Football for winning the 2015 Golden State Bowl title. Head Football Coach Robert Tucker led the team to its first bowl win since 1996. The following is an update on our Monarch Athletic teams:

- [Women's Soccer](#) lost their first round match to Pierce College (0-3) on November 21. The team ended the season with a winning record, and their coach was named as the 2015 WSC Coach of the Year.
- [Men's Football](#) won the Golden State Bowl game against San Bernardino Valley College (45-27). The team took home its first bowl trophy in 19 years!
- [Men's Basketball](#) recently suffered a loss to Ventura College (79-89). The team will play next at LA Trade Tech on December 4 at 7 p.m. and a San Barbara City College tournament on December 11-12.
- The Lady Monarchs of [Women's Basketball](#) opened their season at the Orange Coast Crossover tournament with a loss to Palomar (58-61) and a win against Orange Coast (58-53). It will play in the Tom Gilchrist Invitational at College of the Sequoias on December 3-6, and host the LAVC Russell Classic on December 11-13 at LAVC's South Gym.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving. LACCD TO RECEIVE UP TO \$1.6 MILLION TO FUND FOSTER YOUTH PROGRAMS AT ITS COLLEGES

Los Angeles Valley College and the Los Angeles Community College District (LACCD) will be awarded a portion of \$15 million in funding from the California Community Colleges Board of Governors to fund Cooperative Agencies Foster Youth Educational Support (CAFYES) programs at 10 community college districts in the state. The LACCD anticipates receiving up to \$1.6 million to help fund foster youth programs at its nine colleges in the District. CAFYES programs throughout the state serve current and former foster youth by establishing an educational program that provides services promoting academic success. There are nearly 13,000 current and former foster youth who are enrolled at California community colleges. At Valley College, the CAFYES program is called LAVC Guardian Scholars, which is a new foster youth program that provides support for current and former foster youth attending Valley College. The program joins together the efforts of all campus student support services to assist students in reaching their academic goals.
