[FOOD SERVICES, BUSINESS OFFICE, HEALTH CENTER, AND STUDENT LIFE OFFICE ARE MOVING TO THE STUDENT UNION](#)

The new Student Union building will be the new home of the LAVC Monarch Store (bookstore), Business Office, Cafeteria, Student Health Center, and the Office of Student Life. In addition, it will house a new Lion's Den, Faculty Lounge, and a coffee bar. The LAVC Business Office, Food Services (Food Truck), Student Health Center, and the Student Life Office/Associated Student Union will begin moving to the new Student Union this month. The Monarch Store will be moving at a later date. Each office will move moving in at different times so that their moves will cause the least amount of interruption to students, faculty and staff.

The following is a schedule of when each office will be moving into the Student Union:

- The **Business Office** will continue to operate in its current location on the corner of Hatteras Street and Campus Drive until February 24. It will open in the Student Union on Thursday, February 25.
 - The Business Office, which is where students pay their registration fees and purchase their parking permits, will be located on the first floor of the Student Union.
 - On February 25, it will still offer its extended hours of operation of 8 a.m.-7 p.m.
 - Starting February 26, its hours of operation will be Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 8 a.m.-3:45 p.m. and Tuesday from 8 a.m.-6:15 p.m.
- The **Food Services** (provided by the food truck) will be relocating to the new **Cafeteria**. It will be open for business starting on Monday, February 22.
 - The Cafeteria, which will be located on the first floor of the Student Union, will sell food, beverages and snacks. It will be open Monday-Thursday from 7 a.m.-7 p.m. and Friday from 7 a.m.-1 p.m.
- The **Student Health Center** will be moving to the Student Union on Wednesday, March 2, and will be open on the same day.
 - The Student Health Center offers medical and psychological services to students at Valley College. It will be located on the first floor of the west side of the Student Union, and its hours of operation will be Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-6 p.m.
- **Office of Student Life** will begin moving on Friday, February 19 and will open in the Student Union on Monday, February 22.
 - The Student Life Office will be located on the second floor of the Student Union. It will also be the new home for the [LAVC Associated Student Union](#) (ASU), which is the student government at Valley College. Its hours of operation will be Monday-Thursday from 9 a.m.-4:30 p.m. and Friday from 9 a.m.-1 p.m.

- The [LAVC Monarch Store](#) (Bookstore) will continue to operate in its current location in Campus Center until further notice. Information about the Bookstore move will be made available at a later date.

SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE AT THE LAVC FOUNDATION OFFICE; NEW EXTENDED HOURS STARTING FEBRUARY 22

From February 22-March 18, the Los Angeles Valley College Foundation will be open on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. and 1-4 p.m., Wednesdays from 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. and 1-6 p.m., and Fridays from 9 a.m.-12:30 p.m. and 1-3:30 p.m. to accept scholarship applications from qualified LAVC students. The application period for LAVC Foundation Scholarships began on Monday, January 25, and the deadline to submit an application for most scholarships is Friday, March 18. To be eligible for a scholarship, the individual must be enrolled for the Spring 2016 semester at LA Valley College. Any student interested in these scholarships must stop by the LAVC Foundation Office and be prepared to answer questions (such as the Grade Point Average, the number of units that he/she have completed, units enrolled for Spring 2016, and the area of study) so that Foundation staff can assist in providing applications that the student may qualify for. The LAVC Foundation is located in the south entrance of Admin 3. The Admin 3 building is located to the east of the Humanities Building (near the former location of the food truck). [View map](#). The LAVC African American Initiative, LAVC Student Equity and the LAVC Associated Student Union will hold a week of activities a part of its "Black Heritage Celebration" from February 22-25. The following "Black Heritage Celebration" activities will be held:

- On Monday, February 22, there will be a documentary screening of "Dear White People" followed by a discussion from 2-4 p.m. in the Student Services Multipurpose Room (SSC 245)
- On Tuesday, February 23, it will host a "Black Lives, Black Culture" discussion from 2-4 p.m. in the Fireside Room. LAVC students will be able to explore current topics of interest such as "Authentic Notions of Blackness" and "Black Lives Matter vs. All Lives Matter".
- On February 24 from 9 a.m.-1 p.m. in the Student Services Plaza, there will be a outdoor celebration featuring a New Orleans jazz band and lunch catered by Dulan's.
- On February 25, come to an "Are You Game?" activity to help you unwind and have some fun from 1:30-3:30 p.m. in the Fireside Room. Students, faculty and staff will be able to play fun games such as spades, Cards against Humanity, and dominoes. Lunch will be served on a first-come, first-served basis.

WANT TO TAKE THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALANCY TEST? LAVC OFFERS THE HISET TEST AND PRACTICE TESTS

The LAVC Specialized Testing Center in conjunction with the CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Office is now accepting registrations for the official High School Equivalency Test (or HiSET®), and the HiSET® Practice Test. The HiSET® is the new alternative to the GED; the CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET® for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. To be eligible to take the HiSET®, you must be a California resident, be 18 years or older, have a valid government issued identification, and not be currently enrolled in high school. LAVC is an official HiSET® Testing Site, and it offers the following:

- The HiSET® paper-based test is held monthly on a Friday and Saturday (participants must attend both days for each session). Registration is now open for the paper-based test that will be offered on Friday-Saturday, March 18-19; the last day to register is March 8 in Bungalow 14. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 and additional fees may apply (non-refundable). Space is limited and pre-registration is required.
- The HiSET® practice test will give you an idea of how well you may score on the official HiSET® test. The practice test will be offered on Fridays, February 26, March 4 and 11 in Bungalow 14; registration is accepted on the day of the practice test. Practice tests are offered every Friday and by appointment. The fee for the test is \$10.00 (non-refundable).

Admission for the show is \$6 for adults, \$5 for senior

citizens and LAVC students with a valid student ID card, \$4 for kids ages 8-12, and free for LAVC Astronomy Group members with a valid membership card.

GO MONARCHS!—ALL FOUR ATHLETIC TEAMS BRING HOME RECENT WINS; SUPPORT BASEBALL & SOFTBALL AT A HOME GAME

The LAVC Athletics Program congratulates Men's Basketball on its win over Antelope Valley College, Women's Basketball for beating Citrus College, Baseball for winning over El Camino Compton College, and Softball for its landslide win over Rio Hondo College. The following is an update on our Monarch Athletic teams:

- [Men's Basketball](#) is 6-6 in conference play. It won at home against Antelope Valley (78-66) before being defeated at Citrus (65-78).
- The [Women's Basketball](#) team suffered a loss to Antelope Valley (45-47) but ended the week strong with a win over Citrus (52-48). It is now 8-4 in the conference.
- [Baseball](#) lost its second match up against Santa Ana (3-8) but won over El Camino Compton (9-1). It is 3-3 in pre-conference play. Next up, it will have three home games against Folsom Lake on February 26 at 2 p.m. and a double header on February 27 at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. The team will then play at Irvine Valley on March 1 before playing them at home on March 3 at 2 p.m. Its Pasadena game will be played on home turf on March 5 at 12 p.m. Following that, it will play three games against West LA with an away game on March 8, a home game on March 10 at 2 p.m. and an away game on March 12. All home games will be played on the new Baseball field.
- Women's [Softball](#) is 2-4 in the pre-conference. It beat Rio Hondo (12-3) in 5 innings, and then lost to Santa Barbara (1-10). Softball will play at home against Ventura on February 23 at 2:30 p.m., at Moorpark on March 1, at home versus Pierce on March 7 at 2:30 p.m., at LA Mission on March 10 and at Fullerton on March 12. All home games will be played on the new Softball field.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving.
