#### SUMMER HOURS FOR THE CAFETERIA, BOOKSTORE, LION CAFE AND BUSINESS OFFICE!

*The LAVC Cafeteria, Monarch Bookstore, Business Office and the Lion Cafe will be open during Summer Session to serve students, faculty and staff.* The following services will be open during Summer Session 2016:

- The **LAVC Cafeteria**, which is located on the first floor of the Student Union, sells breakfast and lunch menu items, snacks, and drinks on campus. During June 2016, it will be open Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-3 p.m. and closed on Friday-Sunday.
- The **Monarch Bookstore**, which is located next door to the Business Office in the Student Union, sells new and used textbooks, software, supplies, and LAVC gear and apparel. It also offers a textbook buyback every semester/session for students to get cash for their gently used textbooks, and offers textbook rentals. From June 20-August 12 it will be open Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-3 p.m., Friday from 8 a.m.-1 p.m., and closed on Saturday-Sunday.
- The **Lion Cafe** is located on the south east corner of the Student Union (next to the LAVC Monarch Bookstore). It proudly brews Peet's Coffee and offers espresso, lattes, Javiva cold blended coffee drinks, hot and iced teas, iced coffee, fresh pastries and more! The Lion Cafe is open Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-1 p.m. and closed on Friday-Sunday. [View menu](#)
- The **Business Office**, which is located on the first floor on the eastern side of the Student Union, is where students pay their registration fees and purchase their parking permits. Its hours of operation are Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 8 a.m.-3:45 p.m. and Tuesday from 8 a.m.-6:15 p.m.



#### WANT BETTER GRADES? FREE TUTORING & WRITING WORKSHOPS AT LAVC THIS SUMMER

*The LAVC Academic Resource Center offers free tutoring for students during Summer Session 2016 at its General Tutoring Center, Writing Center, and Math Lab on the second floor of the Library and Academic Resource Center (LARC). Free writing workshops are also available on selected dates in LARC 229.*

The following services are available in the LAVC Academic Resource Center during Summer 2016:

- The [LAVC General Tutoring Center](#) is located in LARC 213 and is open Monday-Thursday from 10:30 a.m.-5:30 p.m. and Friday-Saturday from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. It offers students free tutoring by walk-in or appointment. Tutoring is available in a variety of subjects including accounting, astronomy, chemistry, economics, Spanish, and statistics. In addition, it has free textbook, headphone, and laptop rentals, and small group study rooms are available (by reservation). For more information and the tutoring schedule, call (818) 947-2744.
- The [LAVC Writing Center](#) offers students help with writing, and provides walk-in tutoring to help with writing assignments including essays, research papers, personal statements, and scholarship essays. The Writing Center, which is located in LARC 229, is open Monday & Wednesday from 11 a.m.-3:30 p.m., Tuesday & Thursday from 10:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m., and Friday & Saturday from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. For more details, visit the [LAVC Writing Center Web page](#) or call (818) 947-2810.
- Free writing workshops are offered at the LAVC Writing Center during Summer Session 2016 to assist students with their writing assignments. During these workshops, students can bring in drafts of their writing assignments (or come get help on creating their first draft), and a group of tutors will be available to answer specific questions regarding the designated topic; workshops are offered June 15-July 13 (on Monday at 11 a.m., Tuesday at 2 p.m., Wednesday at 11 a.m. and Thursday at 2 p.m.) in LARC 229. - The [LAVC Math Lab](#) is located in LARC 226 and offers help in all levels of math. This is drop-in tutoring lab for students to get help with their math homework. Three to four tutors are available at any given hour to work with students on a one-on-one basis for short periods of time as needed. The tutors circulate around the lab. In addition to tutoring services, the lab also provides the following: computers with math software, textbooks on reserve, a loan program for videos, CDs, and calculators, math worksheets, and class workshops. In addition, the LAVC Library, Computer Commons, and Virtual Valley Help Desk are open during the summer.

- The [LAVC Library](#) is open Monday-Thursday from 8 a.m.-7 p.m. It provides students with access to library materials and services including research help (print and online books, database of online articles databases, etc.), computers and printing, and group study rooms. - The [Computer Commons](#) in LARC 234 has 100 computers available for students to use. The computers have Internet access, MS Office suite, and students can print in black and white for \$0.10 per page, or color for \$0.25 per page. It is open Monday-Thursday from 7 a.m.-7 p.m. and Friday from 7 a.m.-3 p.m.

## **ATTENTION JOB SEEKERS! LAVC IS OFFERING A FREE MANUFACTURING ACADEMY THIS SUMMER**

***The LAVC Job Training Program is offering orientation sessions for a free short-term Manufacturing Academy on June 21 and 28 at 1 p.m. in Engineering 100.***

This 6-week Manufacturing Academy training program will help prepare program participants for careers in the growing manufacturing field, including CNC operator, quality control, machine operator, assembler, materials handler, and deburring technician.

In order to be eligible for the Manufacturing Academy program, participants must meet

the following requirements:

- Veteran of the U.S, Military who has been released from active duty within the last four years,
- OR have been recently laid off and are receiving or exhausted unemployment insurance benefits,
- AND must be available Monday-Friday for a six-week training period starting on July 11, 2016.

The Manufacturing Academy is funded by the City of Los Angeles Workforce Investment Board (WIB) via the WorkSource Centers of Southern California. Program participants must meet criteria requirements set by the City of LA WIB.
