Los Angeles Valley College has posted a [LAVC Online Schedule of Classes](#), which notes which classes may still have open seats in the Fall 2016 semester. This [searchable class schedule](#), which is updated daily, allows students to search which classes sections are open, almost full, or full for the Fall Semester 2016. *Students are encouraged to check this listing often as some classes listed as full may have open seats when other students drop the class.*

The last day to turn in an instructor add permit card to Admissions & Records for classes starting between August 29-September 9 to the LAVC Admissions & Records Office is Friday, September 9.

Students can still register online for classes starting after September 10. If a class is noted as full, then you can attempt to "crash the class" by requesting an add slip from the instructor on the first day of class.

The LAVC Cafeteria and Lion Cafe are open during the Fall semester to serve the campus community. Students, faculty, staff and the visitors can purchase hot food and cold beverages at the Cafeteria, and coffee beverages, cold drinks and snacks at the Lion Cafe.

The **LAVC Cafeteria** is located in SU 133 (on the first floor of the Student Union), and offers fresh, made-to-order food. Choose from a selection of burgers, hot sandwiches, Mexican food, breakfast sandwiches and burritos, and its "famous" chicken strips and fries. Pizza, salads and more are also available

- During the Fall 2016 semester (August 29-December 16), the Cafeteria is open Monday-Thursday from 7:30 a.m.-6:30 p.m. and closed on Friday-Sunday. *Please note: the Cafeteria will be closed on Monday, September 5 for the Labor Day holiday.*

The **Lion Cafe** is located in SU 167 (southeast corner of the Student Union). The Cafe proudly brews Peet's Coffee and offers espresso, lattes, Javiva cold-blended coffee drinks, hot and iced teas, and iced coffee. It also sells fresh pastries, cold sandwiches, cold drinks, snacks, and more!

- From September 5-9, it is open for extended hours of operation:
 - It is closed on Monday (September 5) for the Labor Day holiday
 - Tuesday-Thursday from 7:30 a.m.-7 p.m. and Friday from 7:30 a.m.-3 p.m.
- During the rest of the Fall 2016 semester (September 12-December 16), it will resume its normal hours of operation: Monday-Thursday from 7:30 a.m.-5 p.m. and Friday from 7:30 a.m.-1 p.m.

REGISTER TODAY FOR THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST! LAVC IS A HISET TESTING SITE

The LAVC Specialized Testing Center in conjunction with the CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Office is now accepting registrations for the official High School Equivalency Test (or HiSET®), and the HiSET® Practice Test.

The HiSET® is the new alternative to the GED; the CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET® for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. To be eligible to take the HiSET®, you must be a California resident, be 18 years or older, have a valid government issued identification, and not be currently enrolled in high school.

LAVC is an official HiSET® Testing Site, and it offers the following:

- The HiSET® paper-based test is held monthly on a Friday and Saturday (participants must attend both days for each session). Registration is now open for the paper-based test that will be offered on Friday-Saturday, September 16 and 17; the last day to register is September 7 in Bungalow 14. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 and additional fees may apply (non-refundable). Space is limited and pre-registration is required.
- The HiSET® practice test will give you an idea of how well you may score on the official HiSET® test. The next available practice test will be held on Friday, September 9 at 9 a.m. in Bungalow 14; registration is accepted on the day of the practice test. Practice tests are offered every Friday and by appointment. The fee for the test is \$10.00 (non-refundable).

LAVC OFFERING CPR TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION FOR FACULTY, STAFF AND STUDENTS

EXPLORE THE FALL SKY AT THE LAVC PLANETARIUM SHOW ON SEPTEMBER 9

The LAVC Earth Science Department and the Los Angeles Valley College Astronomy Group will present a public planetarium show titled "The Fall Sky" on Friday, September 9 at 8 p.m. in the LAVC Planetarium; Doors open at 7:30 p.m. With the return of cooler weather, familiar constellations reappear in the Winter sky. "The Fall Sky" will show how you can find these constellations, and will take a humorous look at the myths behind them.
