#### [TAKE ONE MORE CLASS THIS SEMESTER! NEW LATE-START CLASSES ADDED FOR FALL 2016](#)

*The LAVC Academic Affairs Office has recently added 10 new late-start classes sections for Fall Semester 2016. There are now more than 100 short-term classes starting later in the semester (or "late-start") being offered to help students complete their degree, transfer sooner and/or reach their academic goals.*

Fall late-start classes are being offered on-campus, off-campus, and online and include a selection of high-demand and UC/CSU-transferrable courses. Choose from classes in Accounting, Anthropology, Art, Business, Computer Applications and Office Technologies, Child Development, Communications, Counseling, English, ESL, Health, History, Math, Math, Political Science, Sociology, ESL Civics, and more.

That student must then turn in the signed add permit card to the LAVC Admissions & Records Office to be officially enrolled in the class.*

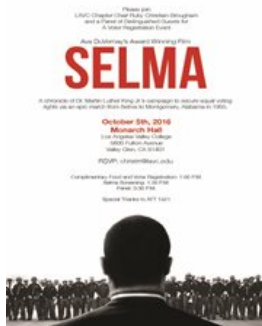
The following are updates from our athletic teams including their upcoming games:

- [Men's Football](#) has a winning record of 3-0 this season. After a landslide win over Glendale (13-0) at home, it goes up against Victor Valley at home on October 1. The Monarchs will then play at Mt. San Jacinto on October 8.
- [Men's Water Polo](#) is now 2-7 for the season and is 0-1 in conference play. At the Cuesta College tournament, the Monarchs won over Diablo College (12-11), lost to Golden West College (6-16) and Delta College (10-11), won American River College (12-2) and then lost to West Valley College (10-11). It lost its first conference match up with Cuesta (8-11) later that week. The team will play at the Riverside Tournament on October 7-8.
- [Women's Soccer](#) is 2-6-2 in the regular season record. The Lady Monarch tied with Moorpark College (1-1) and before sweeping Cerro Cerro College (12-0). Next, the team will play back-to-back home games against Citrus College on October 4 at 7 p.m. and El Camino College on October 7 at 2 p.m. in Monarch Stadium. There is no charge for admission.
- [Women's Water Polo](#) played in the Mount San Antonio College tournament and lost to Long Beach College (2-13), Orange Coast College (4-2), before winning over Ohlone College (12-0) and Cypress (8-4). Next, it will play at Santa Barbara on October 5.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving. 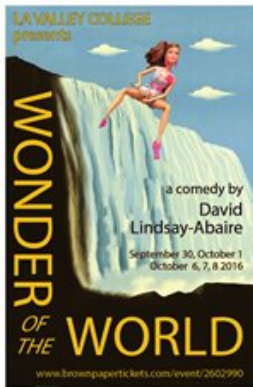

## [JOIN US FOR A "POINT OF NO RETURN - QUASARS AND SUPERMASSIVE BLACK HOLES" PUBLIC PLANETARIUM SHOW ON OCTOBER 7](#)

*The LAVC Earth Science Department and the Los Angeles Valley College Astronomy Group will present a public planetarium show titled "Point of No Return - Quasars and Supermassive Black Holes" on Friday, October 7 at 8 p.m. in the LAVC Planetarium; doors open at 7:30 p.m.*

This planetarium show, which was filmed at the Mueller Planetarium at the University of Nebraska, explores how some galaxies are so far away that all we can see of them are their bright cores; the rest of the galaxy may be too faint for us to observe visually. These bright enigmas are the Quasars, or distant galaxies powered by a supermassive black hole at their core.

Admission for the show is \$6 for adults, \$5 for senior citizens and LAVC students with a valid student ID card, \$4 for kids ages 8-12, and free for LAVC Astronomy Group members with a valid membership card.

The [LAVC Earth Science Department](#) offers courses in the disciplines of astronomy, environmental science, geography, geology and oceanography. In addition, it offers a public astronomy program called the [LAVC Astronomy Group](#), which conduct several public events each month for its members, LAVC students and the public.

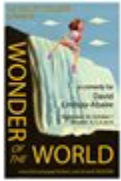
