[FALL LATE-START CLASSES AT LAVC START ON OCTOBER 17!](#)

The Los Angeles Valley College is offering a selection of more than 100 late-start class sections for Fall Semester 2016. These short-term classes that start later in the semester (or "late-start") are offered to help students complete their degree, transfer sooner and/or reach their academic goals.

This Fall, late-start classes are being offered on-campus, off-campus, and online and include a selection of high-demand and UC/CSU-transferrable courses in the subjects of Accounting, Anthropology, Art, Business, Computer Applications and Office Technologies, Child Development, Communications, Counseling, English, ESL, Health, History, Math, Math, Political Science, Sociology, ESL Civics, and more.

STUDENT SUCCESS TIP: *If a class is listed as full, the student should attempt to "crash" the class by attending the first day of class to request an add card from the instructor; if there is space to add the student to the class, the instructor may give an add permit card. That student must then turn in the signed add permit card to the LAVC Admissions & Records Office to be officially enrolled in the class.*

Faculty, staff and students will perform a 60-second earthquake drill to practice on how to protect themselves by dropping, covering, and holding on during an actual earthquake.
