[LAVC RANKED AS THE #2 U.S. PUBLIC CAMPUS FOR PREGNANT & PARENTING STUDENTS](#)

Los Angeles Valley College has been named to the "Top Colleges and Universities for Pregnant and Parenting Students - Public School Edition" by Students for Life in America.

LAVC earned the number two spot in its public college or university list due to its Student-Parent Scholarships for "LAVC student parents who demonstrate financial need and/or are going through a financial hardship" offered through the LAVC Family Resource Center (FRC). The FRC provides resources and support to all members of the LAVC community. It organizes programs such as children playgroups, baby clothes exchange, and a lending library, and offers a child-friendly study lounge, computer lab, and lactation room.

Student Life in America, which is a pro-life youth organization, used the following criteria to determine the list of top schools that foster an environment where students can choose their child and their education:

- must have some kind of support program or network for pregnant and/or parenting students;
- has policies in place that specifically welcome and accept pregnant/parenting students;
- has scholarships for pregnant/parenting students;
- offering housing for students with dependents;
- offers additional resources like lactation rooms, diaper decks, child care for students' children, etc.

The other institutions recognized on the list include University of Washington, Winona State University (Minnesota), University of California, San Diego, University of Utah, Oregon State University, University of Wisconsin, University of New Mexico, Texas A&M University, City College of San Francisco, Norwalk Community College (Connecticut), and the University of Massachusetts. The San Fernando Valley Business Journal recognized Dr. Erika Endrijonas, Los Angeles Valley College president, as one of the most influential people in the San Fernando Valley and beyond in its inaugural issue of its "The Valley 200".

"The Valley 200" introduces the 200 most influential business people and leading opinion shapers in the San Fernando Valley, Santa Clarita Valley and Antelope Valley. Dr. Endrijonas was singled out for the significant achievements and standing in the community.

[MONARCH ATHLETICS UPDATE—CONGRATS TO MEN'S WATER POLO, THE 2016 WSC CHAMPIONSHIPS](#)

The LAVC Athletics Department congratulates Men's Water Polo for winning the Western State Conference Championships, and Men's Football are undefeated this season with their 67-27 victory over Citrus.

The following is an November 7 recap on how the Monarchs performed between October 26-November 5:

- [Men's Football](#) beats Antelope Valley College (38-13) before its win over Citrus College (61-27). The team are ranked #1 in the Southern California American division poll. The undefeated Monarchs plays for an undefeated season and the conference championship at Santa Barbara City College on November 12.
- [Men's Water Polo](#) are the three-time, back-to-back Western State Conference champions (2014, 2015, 2016). At the WSC Water Polo Championships, the team upset number one seeded Cuesta (9-8) and then beat Citrus (11-9) in the final. The Monarchs qualify for the Southern California Water Polo Championships at Golden West College on November 10.
- [Women's Soccer](#) is 4-2 in conference play. The team beat Glendale College (1-0) before losing to Ventura College (1-7), and Pierce College (0-2). The team plays at Santa Monica College on November 8 before wrapping up their season at home on November 11 against West LA College.
- [Women's Water Polo](#) beat Santa Ana College (19-10) and Rio Hondo College (14-11) at the Rio Hondo Mini Tournament. At the WSC tournament, the Monarchs lost two close games to Allen Hancock (8-11) and Cuesta (8-6), but beat Pierce College (19-0) to finish 6th and wrap up their season 17-10.
- [Men's Basketball](#) lost two close games in the Ventura Tournament to Ventura (84-93) and Pasadena (59-83). Next, the team plays at home on November 16 versus Oxnard College at 6 p.m. in the South Gym's competition gym.
- [Women's Basketball](#) opens their season on November 11 at El Camino.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving. 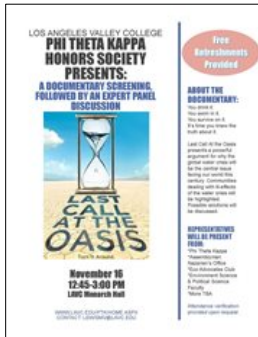
YOU'RE INVITED TO THE FREE WEDNESDAY CONCERT SERIES' LAVC FACULTY RECITAL

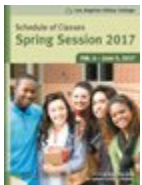
