Students will be able drop a class without a "W" through the legacy LACCD Student Information System by the noted deadline date.



High School Equivalency Test Offered at LAVC! Register for the HiSET or HiSET Practice Test

LAVC CalWORKs Office is an official testing site for the HiSET (a high school equivalency test that is the alternate to the GED)!
