"Site Unseen: Incarceration" Exhibition on Display at the LAVC Art Gallery;

Exhibit Ends April 23

The LAVC Art Gallery presents an exhibition "Site Unseen: Incarceration" by guest curator Sheila Pinkel from March 12-April 23 in the LAVC Art Gallery in the Art Building. "Site Unseen: Incarceration" is a group exhibition by incarcerated artists and non-incarcerated artists that deals with the issue of imprisonment. The exhibit features works by incarcerated artists who express their experience from inside the prison walls, and by non-incarcerated artists who tackle the American criminal justice system from outside its walls. It provides a multiplicity of perspectives on the prison experience, a phenomenon that is both intimidating and unfamiliar to the general public. Featured artists include Alyse Emdur, Anthony Friedkin, Los Angeles Poverty Department, Robert V. Montenegro, Jack L. Morris, Brendan Murdock, Sheila Pinkel, Gabriel Ramirez, Gabriel Reyes, Richard Ross, Robert Stockton, Mark Strandquist, Margaret Stratton, and David Earl Williams. Need to Take the HiSET® (High School Equivalency Test)? LAVC to Offer the Computer-Based and the Paper-Based Test; Practice Test Also Offered

The LAVC CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Program is now accepting registrations for the HiSET® (High School Equivalency Test). LAVC is an official HiSET testing site; the computer-based tests will be offered on Tuesday-Wednesday, March 31-April 1, and the paper-based test on Friday-Saturday, April 3-4. It will also offer the practice test on Friday, April 3; practice tests are also available by appointment. HiSET® is the new alternative to the GED. The CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET® for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. It is offered as a

paper-based or computer-based test, and covers the following subject areas: Language Arts- Reading & Writing, Science, Social Studies and Mathematics. Both types of tests are offered on a regular basis. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 (non-refundable). The fee for the practice test is \$10. Effective March 13, 2015, LAVC employees will receive campus emergency alerts to the contact information noted in the district portal (PCR). Attention Employees—New Key Request Procedure. Effective immediately, LAVC is transitioning to the new Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) and the office of Administrative Services will no longer accept the "Gold Card" Key Request Form. To access the CMMS, first go to the "LACCD Portal" by doing the following steps:

- 1) Go to https://portal.laccd.edu/irj/portal OR- Go to www.lavc.edu, click on the "Faculty and Staff" link on the left hand side, then click on the "Computer Maintenance Management System" link in the black box.
- 2) Log in using your username and password. Use the "First Time User" link for help logging in.
- 3) Once you are logged in, click on the "Work Request" tab and choose "Key Request" to reach the electronic form.
- 4) Fill out the form. When requesting a replacement key, please include your lost key report number when submitting your request.
- 5) Click "Submit" to send the request for approval and processing. All requests must be approved by the Department Chair and VP of Administrative Services.
