Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) will be offering 54 short-term, late-start class sections in the Fall 2015 Semester. These classes, which include a wide selection of UC/CSU-transferrable including online or hybrid courses, are scheduled to start the week of October 19. Late-start courses will be available in the high-demand subjects of English, Math, Communication Studies, Anthropology, Political Science, Art, and more. NEED TO TAKE THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST? LAVC OFFERS HISET TEST AND PRACTICE TESTS; REGISTER TODAY

The LAVC CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids)

Office will offer HiSET practice test on Friday, September 18 at 9 a.m. in Bungalow 14. In addition, it will offer paper-based High School Equivalency Test (HiSET®) on Friday-Saturday, October 16 and 17; the last day to register is October 7. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The HiSET is the new alternative to the GED; the CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. To be eligible to take the HiSET, you must be a California resident, be 18 years or older, have a valid government issued identification, and not be currently enrolled in high school. The HiSET paper-based test is held monthly on a Friday and Saturday (participants must attend both days for each session). The deadline to register for the paper-based test is 7 business days before the test date; participants must register in Bungalow 14. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The fee for

the full test is \$150.00 and additional fees may apply (non-refundable). Space is limited and pre-registration is required. The HiSET practice test will give you an idea of how well you may score on the official HiSET test. They are offered at 9 a.m. on designated Fridays (September 18, 25, October 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30) in Bungalow 14; participants must check-in by 8:45 a.m. The practice test is also available by appointment. Dates are subject to change without notice. The fee for the test is \$10.00 (non-refundable).
