## **HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY TEST OFFERED AT LAVC; HISET PRACTICE TESTS ARE ALSO AVAILABLE**

*The LAVC CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Office will offer the paper-based High School Equivalency Test (or HiSET®) on Friday-Saturday, October 16 and 17; the last day to register is October 7 in Bungalow 14. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. In addition, the HiSET practice test will be offered at 9 a.m. on Friday, September 25*

*in Bungalow 14; check-in at 8:45 a.m.* The HiSET is the new alternative to the GED; the CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. To be eligible to take the HiSET, you must be a California resident, be 18 years or older, have a valid government issued identification, and not be currently enrolled in high school. The HiSET paper-based test is held monthly on a Friday and Saturday (participants must attend both days for each session); the registration deadline is 7 business days before the test date. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 and additional fees may apply (non-refundable). Space is limited and pre-registration is required. The HiSET practice test will give you an idea of how well you may score on the official HiSET test. They are offered at 9 a.m. on designated Fridays (September 25, October 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30) in Bungalow 14; participants must check-in by 8:45 a.m. The practice test is also available by appointment. Dates are subject to change without notice. The fee for the test is \$10.00 (non-refundable).
