*The LAVC Theater Arts Department will present Martin McDonagh's Irish comedy **The Cripple of Inishmaan** on October 22-25 in the Horseshoe Theater in the Theater Arts Building. Evening performances will be held on Thursday, October 22, Friday, October 23, and Saturday, October 24 at 7 p.m. with matinee performances on Saturday, October 24, and Sunday, October 25 at 2 p.m.* The Cripple of Inishmaan takes place on the remote island of Inishmaan, off the west coast of Ireland, circa 1934. The isolated islanders are excited to learn of the arrival of a Hollywood film crew on neighboring Inishmore, there to make a documentary about life on the Aran Islands. 17-year-old Billy Claven, desperate to escape the monotony of Inishmaan, is eager to be a part of the film. An orphan and outcast, "Cripple Billy" has been raised by his harsh but well-meaning aunts, Kate and Eileen, ever since his parents drowned in the rough seas off Inishmaan. It seems that nobody ever really wanted Billy, but perhaps Hollywood will? Maybe that will stop local newsman Johnny Pateenmike's stupid gossiping about him? Or better yet, attract the attention of the beautiful yet terrifying Helen? But first he's got to find a way to cross the sea to Inishmore. Once there, will he ever come back? The production is directed by LAVC professor Cathy Susan Pyles, the scenery is designed by Brittany Cobb, the costumes by LAVC adjunct professor Mary Reilly, and the lighting by LAVC Performing Arts Technician Mark Svastics. The cast includes LAVC students Josh Esquivel, Lily Alquist, Nick Goodreau, Vira Sovyuk, Nikki Boon, Ashley Stagliano, Justin Delacroix, Robert Butler and Cole Castine. [WANT TO TAKE THE HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALANCY TEST? LAVC IS OFFERING THE HISET PRACTICE TEST ON OCTOBER 30; THE OFFICIAL](#)

The LAVC CalWORKs (California Work Opportunity and Responsibility to Kids) Office is offering the HiSET practice test on Friday, October 30 at 9 a.m. in Bungalow 14; check-in at 8:45 a.m. In addition, it will offer the paper-based High School Equivalency Test (or HiSET®) on Friday-Saturday, November 20 and 21; the last day to register is November 11 in Bungalow 14. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The HiSET is the new alternative to the GED; the CA State Board of Education approved the HiSET for individuals to earn a California High School Equivalency Certificate. To be eligible to take the HiSET, you must be a California resident, be 18 years or older, have a valid government issued identification, and not be currently enrolled in high school. The HiSET practice test will give you an idea of how well you may score on the official HiSET test. They are offered at 9 a.m. on designated Fridays (October 30) in Bungalow 14; participants must check-in by 8:45 a.m. The practice test is also available by appointment. Dates are subject to change without notice. The fee for the test is \$10.00 (non-refundable). The HiSET paper-based test is held monthly on a Friday and Saturday (participants must attend both days for each session). The paper-based test will be offered on November 20 and 21, and December 11 and 12; the registration deadline is 7 business days before the test date. The computer-based test is available by appointment only. The fee for the full test is \$150.00 and additional fees may apply (non-refundable). Space is limited and pre-registration is required. [GO MONARCHS!—LAVC ATHLETICS TO HOLD A "BE THE MATCH" DRIVE ON OCTOBER 28](#)

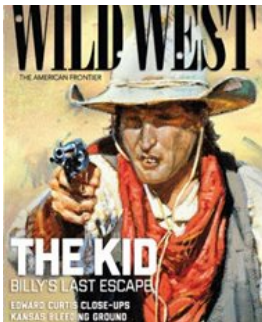
