[HAVE YOU HEARD? LAVC TO HOLD A CAMPUS-WIDE LOCKDOWN DRILL ON NOVEMBER 4](#)

Los Angeles Valley College in partnership with the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department will conduct a campus-wide lockdown drill exercise on Wednesday, November 4. The drill, which will begin at 10 a.m. and will last approximately 15 minutes, will give all students, faculty and staff the opportunity to practice what they should do during a situation of a campus lockdown. In light of the recent tragic events at Umpqua Community College in Oregon, it stressed the need for the entire Monarch community to prepare themselves in the event of campus lockdown due to an active shooter or other emergency. The campus-wide lockdown drill will give everyone the opportunity to practice what to do during a lockdown, and also engage in a dialogue on ways to respond. Before the lockdown drill, all students, faculty and staff are being urged to visit the "Active Shooter" information on the [LAVC Emergency Response Plan Web page](#). During the drill, students, faculty and staff will be asked to temporarily barricade and/or lock their classroom or office doors. College administrators and/or Sheriff's personnel, including Cadets, will then be walking through campus buildings during the drill checking that doors are locked and entrances are—at the very least—barricaded. Additional information will be sent out about the lockdown exercise by email to students, faculty and staff from the LAVC Administrative Services Office. The LAVC Earth Science Department and the Los Angeles Valley College Astronomy Group will present a public planetarium show titled "Point of No Return - Quasars and Supermassive Black Holes" on Friday, November 6 at 8 p.m. in the LAVC Planetarium; Doors open at 7:30 p.m.

This planetarium show, which was filmed at the Mueller Planetarium at the University of Nebraska, explores how some galaxies are so far away that all we can see of them are their bright cores; the rest of the galaxy may be too faint for us to observe visually. These bright enigmas are the Quasars, or distant galaxies powered by a supermassive black hole at their core. Admission for the show is \$6 for adults, \$5 for senior citizens and LAVC students with a valid student ID card, \$4 for kids ages 8-12, and free for LAVC Astronomy Group members with a valid membership card. The [LAVC Earth Science Department](#) offers courses in the disciplines of astronomy, environmental science, geography, geology and oceanography. In addition, it offers a public astronomy program called the [LAVC Astronomy Group](#), which conduct several public events each month for its members, LAVC students and the public. ATHLETICS UPDATE!—ATHLETES CLEAN UP CAMPUS; LAVC TO HOST WATER POLO CONFERENCE CHAMPIONSHIPS

The LAVC Athletics Department would like to thank all the athletes that participated in a Campus Clean Up. Members of the Men's Water Polo, Women's Water Polo, Women's Soccer and Football teams gathered on the campus on October 16 to pick up trash and help keep the Valley College campus beautiful. For the upcoming week, Women's Soccer will play at home against Citrus on Tuesday, November 3, Men's and Women's Water Polo will play in the Western State Conference Championships on Thursday-Saturday, November 5-7 at Valley, and Football has a home game against Glendale on Saturday, November 7 at 6 p.m. The following is an update (for the past several weeks) on our Monarch Athletic teams:

- The [Men's Water Polo](#) has a 3-0 conference record, and will be heading to the Western State Conference Championship. The team had three big wins against Orange Coast (11-9), Palomar (15-8), and Riverside (19-15) at the Riverside Tournament on October 9-10. It triumphed over Santa Monica (21-7) on October 14, Chapman College (16-11) on October 17, and American River (15-3) on October 22. The team had a successful run at the Golden West Tournament on October 23-24 with wins against Delta (18-3), West Valley (18-12) and Riverside (18-12) but a loss to Cerritos (11-13). They are getting ready for the Western State Conference Championships, hosted by Valley College, on Thursday-Saturday, November 5-7.
- The [Women's Water Polo](#) heads to the Western State Conference Championship with a 7-0 record! It beat Pierce College (19-6) on October 7, and Ventura College (9-8) on October 14. It took home three wins against El Camino (13-0), San Diego Miramar (5-0) and Pasadena (9-6) and a loss to San Diego Mesa (7-14) at the Citrus College tournament. However, on October 21 they did beat Citrus College (9-6). They a split at their Long Beach tournament on October 23-24 with wins against Rio Hondo (18-5) and Saddleback (13-12) and losses to Cypress (8-10) and Palomar (6-8). The team just beat Santa Monica College (15-5) at home on October 28. The Western State Conference Championships for Women's Water Polo will be held at Valley College on Thursday-Saturday, November 5-7.
- [Women's Soccer](#) is at the top of the conference with a 7-0-2 record! It won against Antelope Valley (3-0) on October 6, but had a draw to both College of the Canyons (0-0) on October 9 and Citrus College (0-0) on October 13. Since October 16, the team has had back-to-back wins over West LA College (2-0), Glendale (1-0), Bakersfield (1-0) and Santa Monica (3-0)! It will play Antelope Valley on October 30, at College of the Canyons on October 3, and at home against Citrus College on October 5 at 6 p.m. in Monarch Stadium.
- The [Men's Football](#) team has a 5-2 overall and a 3-1 conference record. The team won at Santa Barbara (28-27) on October 17, but it was a tough loss at Santa Monica (20-28) on October 24 in a well-played junior college contest. The "battle for the bell" is at stake at the next home game against Pierce College on October 31 at 12 p.m. in Monarch Stadium. Football will also play at home against Glendale on November 7 at 6 p.m. in Monarch Stadium.
- [Men's Basketball](#) will open their season at a tournament in Ventura on November 5-7.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving.
