[ATHLETICS UPDATE!—LAVC MEN'S WATER POLO ARE THE WESTERN STATE CONFERENCE CHAMPS!](#)

The LAVC Athletics Department congratulates the LAVC Men's Water Polo team for its second consecutive Western State Conference Championship title. The team now heads to the Southern California Championship Tournament on November 12-14, and will play Citrus College. There are no home games scheduled for the week of November 15-21. The following is an update on our Monarch Athletic teams:

- Following a decisive 23-3 win over Ventura and edging Citrus 15-14, the Monarchs' [Men's Water Polo](#) team were officially crowned Western State Conference champions for the second consecutive season. The team now heads to Mt. San Antonio this week as they continue their run toward the state championship. In what should be an exciting rematch, the fourth seed Monarchs will battle fifth seed Citrus at Mt. San Antonio College. Game time is slated for 10:15 a.m.
- The [Women's Water Polo](#) team won against Ventura (10-8) at the Western State Conference tournament, but suffered a disappointing loss to Santa Barbara City College (8-10).
- [Women's Soccer](#) tied against Citrus College (2-2) on November 5, and won against at West LA (4-0) on November 10. It's next home game will be against Glendale on November 13 at 3 p.m. in Monarch Stadium.
- The [Men's Football](#) team pounced all over Glendale (15-7) on November 7. The team will play its final game of the regular season at West L.A. College on November 13 at 1 p.m.
- [Men's Basketball](#) kicked off its season with a loss to Santa Barbara (60-67) and two wins against Pasadena (76-57) and Orange Coast (84-79) at the Ventura College tournament on November 5-7. It will next play at Oxnard College on November 17 at 7 p.m.
- The Lady Monarchs of [Women's Basketball](#) will open their season at the Orange Coast Crossover tournament on November 19-20.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving. Six LAVC students will present at the annual Southern California Conferences for Undergraduate Research (SCCUR) on Saturday, November 21, 2015 at Harvey Mudd College. Lauren Busby, Arteen Galstyan, Jereme Badger, David Flores, Michael Frawley and Aaron Brown will present "Partitioning Exotic Spheres to Examine the Holographic Universe", under the guidance of Shanna Dobson,

adjunct instructor of Mathematics. The LAVC Math Department is sponsoring the presenters, and five other students to the conference. Most of them are students in Math 285 (Independent Study), which is a class team-taught by George Caleodis, Luz Shin and Shanna Dobson that discusses math topics beyond courses offered at Valley College including Group Theory, Topology and Mathematical Physics. The Southern California Conferences for Undergraduate Research (SCCUR) is an organization of Southern California faculty, administrators, and interested members of the community who share the common goal of improving education for college and university students through hands-on experiences of undergraduate research, scholarship, and creative activity. SCCUR supports inquiry-based education, in which students learn while doing, working closely with faculty mentors on significant academic projects and presenting their results to audiences in a professional manner.
