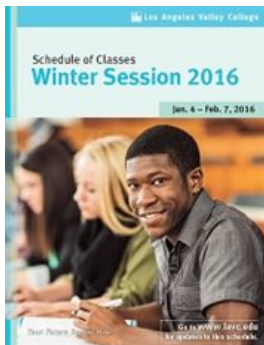

[LA VALLEY COLLEGE WILL BE CLOSED ON SELECTED DATES FOR THE 2015 WINTER BREAK](#)

Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) will be closed on Thursday-Sunday, December 24-27 and Wednesday-Thursday, December 30-31, 2014 and Friday-Sunday, January 1-3, 2015 for Winter Break. The college will be open on Monday-

Wednesday, December 21-23 and Monday-Tuesday, December 28-29, but most offices will be closed and some offices may only be able to offer limited services. All visitors should check with the office they wish to visit before coming to campus. During the winter break, faculty and staff should be aware that access to most buildings and/or rooms on campus will only be given by making prior arrangements with the Sheriff's Office. GO MONARCHS!—CONGRATULATIONS TO THE MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM ON ITS RECENT WIN!

The LAVC Athletics Department congratulates the Men's Basketball Team for their recent win against LA Trade Tech College. In addition, it invites campus community to cheer on our men's and women's basketball teams at their first Western State Conference division home games on January 9 home games against Santa Monica

City College; the women will play at 3 p.m. and the men will play at 5 p.m. The following is an update on our Monarch Athletic teams:

- The LAVC [Men's Basketball](#) won against LA Trade-Tech (81-76) on December 4. The team will play next at the San Barbara City College tournament on December 11-12, a Glendale tournament on December 17-19, at Irvine Valley College on December 30 at 6 p.m., and at West LA College on January 6 at 7 p.m. In addition, it will have a home game against Santa Monica City College on January 9 at 5 p.m. in the South Gym's competition gym.
- The [Women's Basketball](#) suffered two losses (54-68 and 62-68) at the recent Gilcrest Invitational at Sequoia College. Next, the team will host the LAVC Russell Classic on December 11-13 at LAVC's South Gym, and play in the Golden State Classic in San Francisco on December 18-20, and the Ventura Tournament of Champions on December 28-30. It will play its first two conference games at West LA College on January 6 at 5 p.m. and at home against Santa Monica City College on January 9 at 3 p.m.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving. LAVC FOUNDING FACULTY MEMBER JOSEPH NORDMANN'S ESTATE DONATES \$840,000 IN STOCK TO LAVC FOUNDATION

The Los Angeles Valley College (LAVC) Foundation, the non-profit organization of LAVC, announced that it received a generous gift of \$840,000 stock from the estate of Joseph Nordmann on November 6, 2015. The gift will be earmarked for the Joseph Nordmann Endowed Assistantship with the LAVC Foundation. Joseph Nordmann, who was one of the forty-nine founding members of the LAVC faculty in 1949, passed away in August 2015. He was a former department chair and Professor Emeritus in Chemistry at LAVC, and he taught Chemistry at LAVC until his retirement in 1978. Nordmann was also the founding member of the LAVC Running Club and was the Assistant Coach on the 1955 Football team, which won the Orange Show Bowl that year. During summers in the 1950's and 1960's, Nordmann was a coach's assistant for the Los Angeles Rams and co-authored a book on football formations. He co-owned an environmental laboratory and also won a national award in excellence in college chemistry teaching (as a LAVC Professor) from Manufacturing Chemists' Association – recognition usually reserved for Ivy League professors. When he retired from LAVC, Nordmann

moved to the Monterey Peninsula and found a couple of passions as a writer and a professional artist. His paintings have been showcased often in the Carmel area. Nordmann was a very generous supporter of the LAVC Foundation. He loved the Chemistry Department, so he established the Joseph Nordmann Endowed Assistantship in Chemistry in 2005. He has donated over \$230,000 to the endowment and later expanded the Assistantship (or stipend) to Biology. The Assistantship has provided \$38,000 to students since it was established. He expressed great appreciation to Valley College for giving him the opportunity to work in a wonderful environment with wonderful people. He says his donations to the LAVC Foundation are just a small token of his appreciation. The LAVC Foundation thanks the Nordmann estate for its generosity.



LAVC PROFESSOR SPEAKS AT NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF PROFESSORS OF HEBREW CONFERENCE

Zev Garber, professor emeritus of Jewish Studies at LAVC, spoke at the National Association of Professors of Hebrew's Annual Meeting of the Society of Biblical Literature Conference on November 22-23 in Atlanta, Georgia. Zev led a panel

discussion on "Post-missionary Messianic Judaism Ten Years Later: Assessing the Value and Viability of Mark Kinzer's Proposal for the Role of Jewish Followers of Jesus in the Jewish-Christian Relations". Councilmember Paul Krekorian and the Los Angeles City Council recognized the contribution of the LA Fellows Program at Los Angeles Valley College at the LA City Council meeting on Wednesday, December 9. Councilman Paul Krekorian, Los Angeles City Council District 2, commended the LA Fellows Program for its success in re-training 315 individuals in the Los Angeles region, who have provided 31,500 hours of

skilled volunteer time that resulted in nearly \$850,500 of in-kind contributions to the nonprofit community in and around Los Angeles. In addition, Past LA Fellow members Derrick Clemons (LA Fellows Cohort 10) and Jan Share (LA Fellows Cohort 8) shared their experience in the program and how it helped them lead to employment. Scott Svonkin, LACCD Board of Trustees President, and Dr. Erika Endrijonas, LAVC President, accepted the recognition on behalf of the program.
