## **LAVC'S STUDENT UNION BUILDING WINS AWARD FROM ENR CALIFORNIA**

***Engineering News-Record (ENR) California awarded LAVC's Student Union with an "Award of Merit - Southern California" in the category of Higher Education/Research category at the ENR California Best Project 2016 Awards.***

The Student Union (which received the award under its construction project name of Monarch Center) was designed by LPA, Inc. and built by McCarthy Building Construction. It features a multi-level design that incorporates a skybox and high canopy architectural elements. The student-center building is home to the college's bookstore, business office, cafeteria, a coffee bar, student health center, and student life office.

The award winners for ENR California's Best Projects 2016 was selected by a panel of industry judges—including architects, engineers, contractors, public and private owners, and subcontractors. The judges panel reviewed and discussed more than 90 projects located throughout California and Hawaii. Projects were evaluated on the ability of the project team to overcome challenges, its contribution to the industry and community, its safety and construction and the design quality.

The awards were presented at two regional awards presentations; one award presentation took place in Los Angeles on October 4, and the other in San Francisco on December 6.

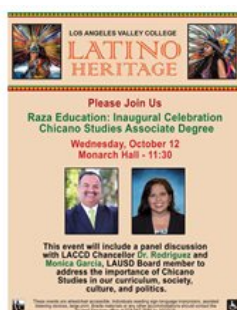
*The LAVC Athletics Department congratulates Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men's Water Polo for their recent victories. Don't forget to show your "Monarch Pride" at the Women's Soccer and Women's Water Polo home games!*

The following is an update on our athletic teams and their upcoming games:

- The #1 ranked [Men's Football](#) team is now 4-0 for the season. Following a victorious win over Victor Valley College (52-21), it will play at Mt. San Jacinto College on October 8 and then at Pierce on October 15.
- [Men's Water Polo](#) has a 3-8 record this season. At the Cerritos College mini tournament, the team beat Rio Hondo College (17-6) and lost to Palomar College (9-12). The Monarchs suffered a disappointing loss against Citrus College (11-13) Next, the team will play at a Riverside College tournament on October 7-8, and at Ventura College on October 12.
- As of this week, [Women's Soccer](#) is 3-8-2 in the regular season. The Lady Monarchs lost to Oxnard College (0-1) and Citrus College (0-1) before its win over El Camino College (2-1). Come watch them battle Glendale College on October 11 at 4 p.m. in Monarch Stadium. There is no charge for admission.
- [Women's Water Polo](#) brings its season record to 5-4 after losing in its match up against Santa Barbara City College (5-20). Next up, the Monarchs will take on Pierce College at home in the Aquatics Center on October 12 at 3:30 p.m.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall.
