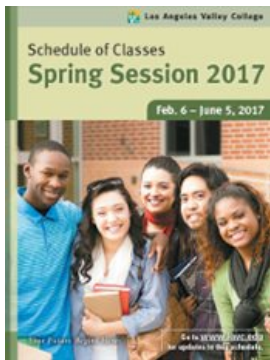

The LAVC Academic Affairs Office has posted the Spring 2017 Schedule of Classes on the LAVC Class Schedule Web page. Spring Semester 2017 will take place from February 6-June 5.

This Spring, LAVC will be offering a variety of on- and off-campus course offerings during the day, evening and Saturdays as well as short-term, online and hybrid classes. There is a wide-range of CSU/UC transferrable, career-technical education, non-credit and online and hybrid courses. Priority registration for designated groups begins on November 14.

Current LAVC students can find their Spring 2017 registration appointment by logging into the [LACCD Student Information System](#) (or by clicking the "Register" link on the college homepage). *To log in, enter the student identification number and pin number; continue past the information page and select "View Reg Appt", and select "Spring 2016" and submit.*

New and returning students will need to [apply online](#) by visiting www.lavc.edu and clicking "Apply" link.

STUDENT SUCCESS TIP #1: If you wish to add a class that is listed as full by the time of your registration appointment, continue to try at a later date as seats become available as soon as someone drops the course.

STUDENT SUCCESS TIP #2: You can also attempt to add the class by attending the first day of classes to request an add card from the instructor if space is available. If you get an add card, submit it to LAVC Admissions & Records Office for processing.



[LAVC RECEIVES \\$50,000 FROM THE COLLEGE TEXTBOOK AFFORDABILITY ACT](#)

The California State Chancellor's Office has awarded Los Angeles Valley College \$50,000 from the College Textbook Affordability Program to create no- or low-cost textbooks online for students.

The goal of the College Textbook Affordability Act of 2015 (AB 798) is to save college students money by empowering professors and local campuses to adopt high quality, free and open educational resources for course materials. AB 798 was sponsored by Assemblywomen Susan A. Bonilla.

LA Valley College will use the funds to provide grants for professors to develop open educational resource materials for classes that students can use for their classes. In addition, there will be training and professional development on how to create and use open resource materials in the classroom. Josh Miller will be leading LAVC's open educational resources efforts as Valley College's textbook affordability campus coordinator (TACC).

LAVC REPLACING ALL VENDING MACHINES ON CAMPUS FROM OCTOBER 26-NOVEMBER 4

The LAVC Administrative Services Office announced that it is removing the current vending machines on campus and then will be replacing those machines with new vending machines. This is being done as part of a campus-wide upgrade to all the vending machines at Valley College.

The following is a schedule of activities to update the college's vending machines:

- **On Wednesday, October 26**, the vending machines at the Student Union, Allied Health & Sciences Center, College House, Maintenance & Operations, and Theater Art locations will be removed.
- **On Thursday, October 27**, the vending machines at the Behavioral Sciences, Community Services Center, and the Aquatics Center locations will be removed.
- **On Friday, October 28**, the vending machines at the Business Journalism, and Campus Center locations will be removed.
- **From Monday-Friday, October 31-November 4**, the vending machines across the campus will be replaced with new machines.

During the vending machine removal and replacement process, students, faculty, staff and visitors are encouraged to visit the Cafeteria, Monarch Bookstore or Lion Cafe in the Student Union to purchase food, drinks and snacks. Scantrons and bluebooks are available for purchase at the LAVC Monarch Bookstore in the Student Union.

[ATHLETICS UPDATE—CHEER ON SOCCER & FOOTBALL AT HOME THIS WEEK](#)

The LAVC Athletics Department congratulates Football for its conference win over Allen Hancock, Women's Soccer for beating both Santa Monica (in its first game played on the new field) and West LA, Men's Water Polo for winning San Joaquin

Delta and American River in its final two games of the Golden West Tournament and Women's Water Polo for its win over San Diego Mesa at the Long Beach Tournament.

All students, faculty and staff are invited to show their "Monarch Pride" while rooting for the Monarchs at an upcoming home match-up. The Women's Soccer will play Ventura College on Monday, October 31 at 3 p.m. and Pierce College on Friday, November 4 at 4 p.m. in the Athletics grass field; free admission. Football will play Citrus College at its sophomore/faculty appreciation game on Saturday, November 5 at 6 p.m. in Monarch Stadium; tickets are \$7 for adults and \$3 for students.

The following is an update how our Monarchs have performed last week as well as their upcoming games:

- [Men's Football](#) is 7-0 following their conference win over Allen Hancock College (54-27). At this "Be the Match" Cancer recognition game, LAVC's Head Water Polo Coach Jim McMillan served as its honorary captain. The team will next play Antelope Valley College (the other top teams in the conference) on October 29. Following that game, the Monarchs will hold a "sophomore/faculty appreciation night" at its home game against Citrus College on November 5 at 6 p.m. in Monarch Stadium; admission is \$7 for adults and \$3 for students.
- [Men's Water Polo](#) recently played at the Golden West Tournament and lost to Cerritos College (5-11) and Riverside College (4-9) before bringing home back-to-back wins over San Joaquin Delta (13-11) and American River College (10-2). Next, it will prepare for the WSC championships at Cuesta College on November 3.
- [Women's Soccer](#) is 5-9-2 for the season. The team recently made history when it opened up its new home soccer venue on the brand-new Athletics grass field at its landslide win over Santa Monica College (3-0). The team also beat West LA College (1-0) on the road. Coming up, it will play at home against Ventura College on October 31 at 3 p.m. and Pierce College on November 4 at 4 p.m. on the Athletics grass field; admission is free to the game.
- [Women's Water Polo](#) is now 4-3 in conference play following its one win at the Long Beach Tournament over San Diego Mesa College (7-0) and its three losses to Riverside College (1-18), Citrus College (7-10) and Palomar College (4-10). The team also lost at home to Citrus College (14-15).
- [Men's Basketball](#) and [Women's Basketball](#) look to open their season in November.

The LAVC Athletics Department's Monarch Athletics program comprises of 10 intercollegiate athletic teams. The Men's Football, Women's Soccer, and Men and Women's Water Polo teams play every fall. Spring team sports include Men's Baseball, Men's and Women's Basketball, Women's Softball, and Men's and Women's Swimming and Diving. 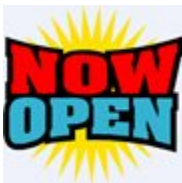
