[ATTENTION STUDENTS! UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA EXTENDS ITS TRANSFER APPLICATION DEADLINE](#)

The University of California (UC) has announced that it has extended the deadline for transfer applications to January 3, 2017 for most majors.

This extension gives more community college students the opportunity to have additional time to apply, and widens the application window for qualified students preparing the transfer to a University of California campus. Interested students are still encouraged to apply during the priority filing period during November 2016, as the extension may not apply for certain programs and majors at some UC campuses.

According to a press release, the UC has boosted the number of Transfer Pathways, which outlines a set of course expectations for prospective transfer students to prepare for a major at any of the UC's undergraduate campuses, as part of a series of efforts to assist transfer students. The UC's goal is to enroll one new transfer student for every two new freshmen.

[LAVC COMMUNITY INVITED TO JOIN NEIGHBORHOOD RESIDENTS AT THE VALLEY GLEN COMMUNITY CLEAN UP EVENT ON NOVEMBER 12](#)

The Valley Glen Neighborhood Association, in partnership with the Los Angeles City Councilman Paul Krekorian's Office and the Greater Valley Glen Council, is seeking volunteers for its Valley Glen Clean-Up event on Saturday, November 12.

Volunteers will gather at the Clean Streets LA command post on the southeast side of Valley Glen Community Park at 6150 Atoll Ave in Valley Glen (the park is bordered by Atoll Avenue, Erwin Street and Ethel Avenue) at 8 a.m., and the half-day project will end at 12 noon.

This community clean-up project will tackle trash blight, graffiti and cast-offs items with a unique combination of social media, mobile teams and on-the-ground cleanup crews—as part of an effort to compete for a Clean Streets LA Award. Los Angeles City's Department of Sanitation launched the Clean Streets LA project to improve livability and cleanliness by targeting litter and debris on city streets, sidewalks and alleys. About 50 local Los Angeles communities will compete for recognition and cash awards.

The Valley Glen project will combine a posse of driving patrols reporting via myLA311.com with on-the-ground youth cleanup crews armed with rakes, shovels and trash bags. The effort will deploy teams for a street-by-street assessment of six basic districts of the greater Valley Glen area and identify abandoned waste hot spots. Volunteers will use cell phones to document trash and post activity to Facebook, Twitter and other media. Volunteers will also distribute handout information to apartment owners and business owners on how they can report illegal dumping, and remove abandoned trash and cast-off refuse.

There will be free coffee and donuts courtesy of Lusy's Mediterranean Café & Grill and a free lunch served at the conclusion of the project.

DON'T MISS THE AGS GUITAR CONCERT BY STELA MITEVA-DINKOVA

The LAVC Music Department in partnership with the American Guitar Society (AGS) will present a concert performance by Stela Miteva-Dinkova, guitar, on Saturday, November 12 at 8 p.m. in Music 106 (Music Recital Hall).

A native of Bulgaria, Stela Miteva-Dinkova has garnered several prizes in national and international competitions, and has performed throughout Europe, America and Africa including major festivals in Spain, the Czech Republic, Germany, Poland and Serbia. An associate professor at the Plovdiv Academy of Music, Dance and Fine Arts since 1996, she is a strong exponent of Bulgarian music and recently published two collections of guitar music by Bulgarian composers, the first of their kind. Classical Guitar declares her to be "highly talented and quite charismatic."

Tickets are \$20 for general admission, \$15 for students and seniors, and \$10 for AGS members and LAVC students.
