[CONGRATS TO LAVC'S STUDENT UNION FOR RECEIVING TWO MORE AWARDS!](#)

The Student Union at Los Angeles Valley College (known by its construction project name of "Monarch Center") has been awarded with a "2016 Award of Merit" in the Educational Facilities category from the Design-Build Institute of America (DBIA). In addition, the Community College Facility Coalition (CCFC) awarded the building with an "2016 Award of Excellence" in the Growth category at the 2016 CCFC Professional Design Awards Ceremony and Luncheon.

DBIA recognized the "Monarch Center" as part of its 21st annual Design-Build Project/Team Awards program based on how the design-builder (McCarthy Building Companies, Inc.) addressed design-build delivery challenges. This included providing Valley College with the best design at the best value possible based on the design criteria, and to help minimize the college's risk and allow for expedited solutions when issues arose in the field.

The DBIA annually recognizes the best design-build projects nationwide for their exemplary collaboration and integration in design-build project delivery. As a new construction project, the CCFC, in partnership with the California Community College Chancellor's Office, honored the "Monarch Center" project's architectural firm (LPA, Inc.) and owner (Los Angeles Valley College) with its highest honor of an "Award of Excellence" in the "Growth" category at its 23rd annual conference in Sacramento on November 15. LAVC President Dr. Erika Endrijonas and LAVC's Build-LACCD Construction Project Director Mark Strauss accepted the award on behalf of the college.

The CCFC honors construction projects at a California community college campuses every year. Projects are awarded based on the merits of its planning process, impact to the learning environment, project design, impact to the community environment, and the role of the its physical environment on the campus by a jury of architects, other industry professionals, community college staff, and/or Chancellor's office staff. - **Students**—In an emergency, current LAVC students will be notified through their LACCD student email address (@student.laccd.edu) and the phone number(s) on file in their student records. Students can choose to forward their LACCD emails to a personal email address; [Read instructions on how to set up your LACCD account emails to forward to your personal email](#). Students who wish to update their phone numbers on their student records will need to submit a Student Information change form to the LAVC Admissions and Records Office.

LAVC has been using Blackboard Connect to send emergency alert notifications to students, faculty and staff since 2014. This system allows the college to simultaneously send emergency notifications by email, voice message, and text message.

[HAVE YOU HEARD? OFFICES MOVING INTO THE ADMINISTRATION & CAREER ADVANCEMENT BUILDING STARTING DECEMBER 9!](#)

The Academic Affairs Office, Academic Senate, Administrative Services Office, Budget Office, CalWORKS Office/Assessment Center, Continuing Education, Cooperative Education, Foundation Office, Institutional Effectiveness Office, Ombudsperson Office, Payroll/Personnel Office, President's Office, Public Relations Office, Staff Services (Operator, Mailroom, Master Calendar, Reprographic Services), and Workforce Training Office will be moving to the new Administration and Career Advancement (ACA) building.

Offices will stagger their move from their current locations on campus so that the transition will be easier for the campus community. 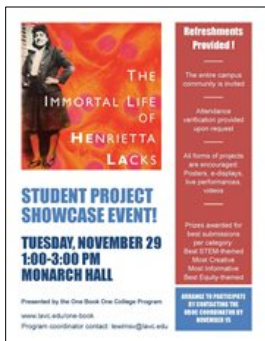
[CHECK OUT THE "WE MAKE OUR OWN TIME" FACULTY EXHIBIT AT THE LAVC ART GALLERY!](#)

[DISCOVER THE SECRETS OF THE CARDBOARD ROCKET AT THE LAVC PLANETARIUM SHOW!](#)

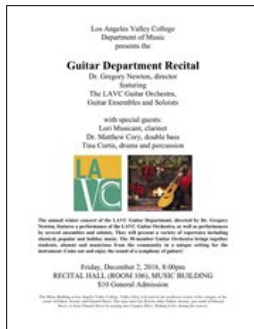
The LAVC Earth Science Department and the Los Angeles Valley College Astronomy Group will present a public planetarium show titled "The Secrets of the Cardboard Rocket" on Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. in the LAVC Planetarium; Doors open at 7:30 p.m.

This 45-minute show from the Clark Planetarium in Salt Lake City is geared for young luminous children ages 8 and above and their parents, and tells the tale of two young kids, who get the trip of their life as they tour the solar system. *Note: Children should be prepared to watch the show in a dark theater.*

Admission for the show is \$6 for adults, \$5 for senior citizens and LAVC students with a valid student ID card, \$4 for kids ages 8-12, and free for LAVC Astronomy Group members with a valid membership card.
