The LAVC Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS), Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education (CARE) and Guardian Scholars programs are accepting new students for the Spring 2017 semester.

Students who meet certain criteria (see [eligibility requirements](#)) can apply to be a part of one of the following programs:

- **EOPS (Extended Opportunity Programs and Services)** is open to students who come from backgrounds who have historically experienced economic and educational challenges. The [EOPS program](#) assists eligible students who have historically experienced economic and educational challenges. To increase access, retention and goal completion, it provides the following "over and above" services: academic counseling, tutoring, textbook vouchers, workshops, priority registration, progress monitoring, and other services.
- **CARE (Cooperative Agencies Resources for Education)** is open to EOPS students who are single parents. The [CARE program](#) supports the unique needs of EOPS students who are single parents by promoting self-sufficiency and academic success through tailored workshops, additional counseling, educational materials and financial assistance for child care related expenses.
- **Guardian Scholars** is open to current and former foster youth attending Valley College. The [Guardian Scholars program](#) is a foster youth program that provides support for current and former foster youth attending Valley College.

OFFICES BEGIN MOVING TO ADMINISTRATION & CAREER ADVANCEMENT ON DECEMBER 9

Several campus offices and services will begin moving into the new Administration and Career Advancement (ACA) building starting on Friday, December 9.

The Academic Affairs Office, Academic Senate, Administrative Services Office, Budget Office, CalWORKS Office/Assessment Center, Continuing Education, Cooperative Education, Foundation Office, Institutional Effectiveness Office, Ombudsperson Office, Payroll/Personnel Office, President's Office, Public Relations Office, Staff Services (Operator, Mailroom, Master Calendar, Reprographic Services), and Workforce Training Office will be moving to the new ACA building during December 2016.

Offices will stagger their move from their current locations on campus so that the transition will be easier for the campus community. Offices that are moving will be temporarily unable to provide services to students, faculty, staff and the public on their scheduled move date. DR. MARTIN APPOINTED TO LA'S WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

Dr. Llanet Martín, associate dean of student services at LAVC, was sworn into the City of Los Angeles Workforce Development Board (WDB) on November 16, 2016. As an appointed board member by Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti, Dr. Martín will serve a two-year term ending in 2018. In her capacity on the board, Dr. Martín will sit on the Task Force on Underrepresented Populations.

Llanet Martin has more than ten years of experience in academia as a graduate fellow, mentor, residential advisor, researcher, admissions officer, and instructor. She includes among her many accomplishments and skill sets developing and implementing curricula, securing funding for special programming, assisting minority and parenting students in preparing for graduate school, and evaluating and synthesizing data to publish scholarly reports that inform education decision-makers.

In her current capacity as Student Success and Support Services Coordinator with the Los Angeles Community College District, Ms. Martin oversees a number of initiatives to ensure that students successfully complete their community college studies.

Ms. Martin is a member of the Advance Democratic Club, Executive Latino Leadership Association, and UCLA Latino Alumni Association.

The City of Los Angeles WDB oversees the expenditure of more than \$50 million in public funds annually through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA). The LA City Mayor appoints 37 board members from the leadership ranks of the education, economic development and organized labor fields as well as other key players in the Los Angeles economy. The WDB identifies workforce development issues suitable for review, gather and evaluate workforce development information, monitor ongoing workforce development activities, and recommend courses of action for WDB approval. 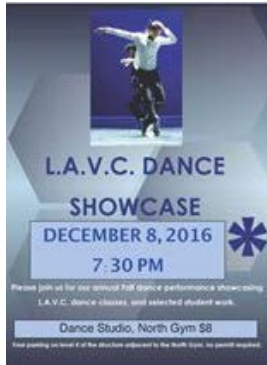
LA VALLEY COLLEGE WELCOMES THE LACCD BOARD OF TRUSTEES ON DECEMBER 7
