® LAVC to Offer the GED Test on August 19-20

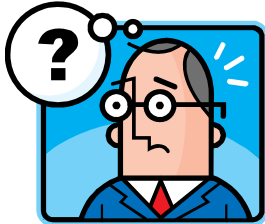
LAVC will offer the GED (General Educational Development) Test on August 19-20; Testing is offered every month through the CalWORKs Office. Registration for the test begins 2 weeks prior to the test, and space is limited. The GED testing fee is \$150; fees must be paid at the time of registration. LAVC is an official testing site for the GED (General Educational Development) Test, which is facilitated by the LAVC CalWORKs Office. LAVC to Offer an Accelerated Math Series to Help Get Math 105 Students to College-Level Math in Just Two Semesters!

LAVC Foundational Skills is offering a new accelerated Math series for students who have placed in Math 105 that will allow them to be prepared to take college-level math in only one year (two semesters). These

accelerated math classes are part of learning community and are paired together with a one unit, Personal Development class to provide students with additional study and test taking skills to help them successfully complete their math classes. During the Fall semester, students would enroll into Math 110 (a 5-unit class that combines Math 105 and Math 112) and Personal Development 1. In the Spring, they would take Math 115/125 (a total of 10 units) and Personal Development 1. After completing all four courses, you will be prepared to take college-level math (Math 225/227 or Math 245). 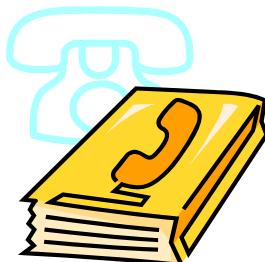
Got Questions Regarding a Campus Construction Project? Get the Latest News and Construction/Parking Updates from the reVitalizing Valley College Web Page
