#### **Attention All Full-time Faculty and Adjuncts! Do you want to learn strategies to teach underprepared students?**

The Basic Skills Initiative is sponsoring the Curriculum Development Project, a series of professional development workshops facilitated by Dr. Jennifer Romack of CSUN and a faculty mentor in student-centered learning, for instructors of foundational skills classes at LAVC (such as English, ESL credit and noncredit, Developmental Communications, Learning Skills, Speech, and Math). The **first workshop on “Creating a classroom climate to support student learning”, which will be held on Monday, January 12 from 12:30-3:30 p.m. in the Faculty Lounge**, will share classroom management strategies to ensure productive student behavior, and will cover topics including establishing connections, promoting readiness for learning, and assessing learning. The **second workshop on “Planning instruction to ensure student success”, which will be on Wednesday, January 14 from 12:30-3:30 p.m. in the Faculty Lounge**, will show how to use a lesson plan template—an effective and efficient planning tool—that integrates research-based principles of effective instruction and best practice. The **final workshop on “Sharing and learning from each other”, which is scheduled for Thursday, January 15 from 12:30-3:30 p.m. in the Faculty Lounge**, where participants will finish their lesson plans and share them with each other. All full-time faculty and adjunct faculty are eligible to apply. Stipends of approximately \$300 will be paid for attending all three workshops and producing lesson plans.
