Construction Notice – Fulton Entry and Monarch Square (Updated)

The official start date of the construction for the Fulton Entry and Monarch Square is **scheduled for Monday, July 14**. For the duration of the summer, signs will be placed throughout campus to redirect vehicle and pedestrian traffic. **Faculty/staff using the College Road South parking lot should enter via the driveway for emergency vehicles off Burbank Avenue** (the blockades will be removed), and the **entrance to the College Road North parking lot is located near the Fulton Avenue entrance to Parking Lot B** (tire damage spikes have been removed). A portion of **College Road North will also be open for temporary visitor parking**. The **new pick up/drop off zone for student and DSPS students will be located in Parking Lot B** (near the Music Building). PLEASE ANNOUNCE TO ALL STUDENTS:

- **Temporary DSPS and Student Pick-up/Drop-off Location Update.** Please note that the main Fulton Avenue entryway will be closed due to construction starting Monday, July 14. For the duration of the summer, the temporary drop-off / pick-up area for students and DSPS students will be located in Parking Lot B (near Fulton Avenue and Oxnard Street). Signs will be placed directing traffic to this alternate pick-up/drop-off area. - **New Change in the Non-resident Tuition Waiver Policy.** Starting in the Fall 2008 semester, all non-resident students enrolled in 4 or fewer units will be exempt from paying non-resident tuition. All non-resident students enrolled in more than 4 units will pay non-resident tuition for all units in which they are enrolled.
