Construction Notice - Fulton Avenue Entryway & Monarch Square Closed

Starting Tuesday, July 1, the Fulton Avenue Entry and Monarch Square will be closed due to construction. The area will be renovated to include new lighting, new pavement, improved walkways, handicap accessible ramps and stairs, an updated bus/car drop off zone, a new bus shelter, and new landscaping with drought-resistant plants. Signs will be placed around campus to re-direct traffic to the following alternate entryways and parking lots: **the temporary entrance to College Road South parking**

lot will be located on Burbank Avenue (the driveway for emergency personnel to the east of the current exit ramp will be opened), **the temporary entrance to College Road North parking lot will be located by the Fulton Avenue driveway to Parking Lot B** (the tire damage spikes on the current exit way will be removed to allow cars to enter), and **the temporary drop-off/pick up zone for students and DSPS students will be located in Parking Lot B**. - **New temporary DSPS and Student Pick-up/Drop-off Location.** Starting Tuesday, July 1, there will be a temporary relocation of the drop-off / pick-up area for students and DSPS due to renovations to the main Fulton Avenue entryway. The new location will be in Parking Lot B (near Fulton Avenue and Oxnard Street). Signs will be placed directing traffic to this alternate pick-up/drop-off area for the rest of summer. - **New Change for the Non-resident Tuition Waiver Policy.** Starting in the Fall 2008 semester, all non-resident students enrolled in 4 or fewer units will be exempt from paying non-resident tuition. All non-resident students enrolled in more than 4 units will pay non-resident tuition for all units in which they are enrolled. Summer Youth Soccer Clinic at LAVC.
