Professional Development/STARS will present two workshops for faculty and staff this week. A **“Excel Basics: Entering Simple Formulas” workshop on Wednesday, June 11** will cover working with operators and orders of precedence, using type and point to complete formulas, creating and copying formulas with relative and absolute numbers, freezing and splitting worksheet display, hiding and revealing rows and columns, displaying formulas and answers, and changing names and file locations. The **“Word Level 2: Formatting Documents” workshop, which is scheduled for Thursday, June 12**, will share tips on setting margins, line and paragraph spacing, text alignment, indentation, bullets and numbered lists, borders and shaded text, and using the “What’s This” feature.
