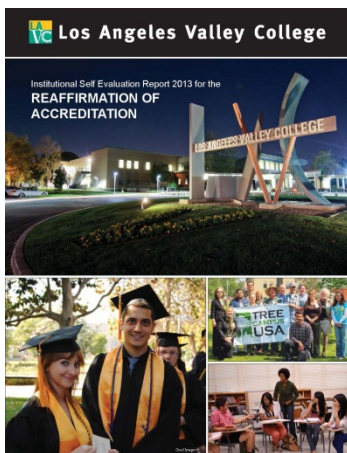
LAVC to Offer the Official GED Test on March 7-9
