#### **Don't Miss One-Stop Registration Day for Summer & Fall 2008**

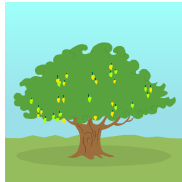

### Save a life in 2008! Learn CPR at LAVC

LAVC will be offering classes for both the **Layperson CPR/AED for the Adult, Child and Infant certification** and the **Professional Rescuer CPR/AED certification**. The classes, which will be taught by Patty Melody, M.A. and Chad Peters, M.S., ATC from the Physical Education Department, will be held on **Tuesdays, May 13 and May 20 in the Exercise Room of the North Gym from 6-9:30 p.m.** To take the class for re-certification, participants only need to attend one (3-1/2 hour) class. Those who are taking the course for the first time should attend both days (for a total of 7 hours); there is no additional charge for attending both classes. These courses are sponsored by the American Red Cross. The class is \$25 per person for the Layperson, and \$35 per person for the Professional Rescuer (all materials and your certification card is included in the fee).
