Artist Doug Harvey to Present a Slide Talk at LAVC

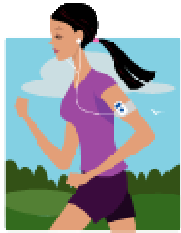

Campus Closed for Thanksgiving Holiday

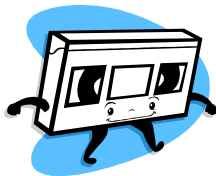
