### **Media Arts Department’s “PatriotS Act” Documentary Receives Recognition**

The Media Arts’s Directed Studies Workshop production of the feature documentary *“PatriotS Act...PEACE PRESS: the People’s Printing Collective”*, done in partnership with the Art department and the Center for the Study of Political Graphics, has garnered its sixteenth international recognition. It was screened at the *3rd Annual L.I.N.K. (Love, Imagine, Network, Kindness) Film Festival* of the S.U.R.G.E. (*Social Uprising, Resistance & Grass Roots Encounter*) International Network in Olympia, Washington. The film examines a unique group of 1960s/70s L.A. artists-activists who created a successful graphic arts business centered around global peace and counter-culture social-issues, proving “art could be both commercial and a weapon for change”. Under producer-director Media Arts professor Joseph Daccurso, all the cinematography, editing, sound were principally done by students Josephine Dell’Anno, Anika Marinelli, Rachel Tucker, Don Lewis II along with Daniel Villegas, Chris Wexler, Randy Yap, and Shervin Ahdout.
