

#### LAVC Summer Session 2014 Classes Begin June 16

**Los Angeles Valley College will offer day and evening classes for Summer Session 2014 starting on Monday, June 16; Saturday Classes will begin June 21. The last day to add a class (by instructor add permit only) is June 18.** The 5-week summer session will take place from June 16-July 20, 2014. This year, there are more than 120 Summer class sections being offered in many disciplines, including English and Math. There will also be several course offerings in the areas of career technical education and noncredit. #### LAVC Cooperative Education Gives College Students the Opportunity to Earn College Credit for Summer Work; Applications Now Being Accepted!

**The LAVC Cooperative Education Office is currently accepting enrollments for Summer Session 2014. Students who are working or interning during the summer may be eligible for 1 to 4 units of college credit. The summer program will begin June 16, and will end on July 25.** Students must be enrolled at Los Angeles Valley College, complete a Summer 2014 Cooperative Education enrollment application, and schedule an appointment to meet with the Cooperative Education Director; Enrollment into the program is by add slip only. The last day to enroll is June 20. Space is limited! **LAVC Student Irene Harutyunyan Selected to Participate in a Summer Medical & Dental Education Program at UCLA**

*Irene Harutyunyan, an LAVC student, has been accepted into the Summer Medical and Dental Education Program (SMDEP). She will participate in the Summer 2014 program at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA and UCLA School of Dentistry.* The SMDEP program is geared for freshman and sophomore college students who have an interest in either medical or dentistry school for their future careers. For six weeks, participants will be able to gain academic enrichment in the basic sciences and quantitative topics, participate in clinical exposure through small-group clinical rotations and full-group clinician seminars, and receive career development guidance for medical and dental careers. Irene plans to go to medical school, and this will be her first-hand experience into the field. Congratulations Irene!



**LAVC Student Angelina Cabral to Participate in a Summer Community College Research Internship at USC**

*Angelina Cabral, an LAVC student, has been selected to participate in the Community College Research Internship for Scientific Engagement (CC-RISE) Internship Program at USC for during the summer of 2014.* CC-RISE is an eight-week, paid, summer research internship program for community college students run by the Center for Dark Energy Biosphere Investigations (C-DEBI). Participants will gain first-hand exposure to the scientific process by working in a faculty-led research lab at the University of Southern California (USC). The selected participants will conduct research 40 hours/week, focused on a project in a microbiology/geochemistry lab, and will be mentored and trained in research procedures. In addition to research, they will participate in activities focusing on how to transition from a two-year college to a university and information on graduate school. At the end of the program, students present their results to an audience of peers and mentors. Congratulations Angelica!

Classes will be added by instructor add permit only; students must submit their add permits for credit, non-credit or audit with the LAVC Admissions Office by the deadline. Students who wish to enroll in a class that is full should go on the first day of class to ask the instructor for an add permit. Students are responsible for dropping their own classes using the Student Information System.
